

MINUTES OF THE REGULAR SCHOOL BOARD MEETING
INDEPENDENT SCHOOL DISTRICT NO. 777, Benson, Minnesota
Monday, September 14, 2020 - 5:30 p.m. – Northside Elementary School Cafeteria & Virtual Meeting

Approval of Agenda: Motion by B. McGeary, second by P. Carruth to approve the agenda. Motion carried (6-0).

Progress Reports:

PK-5, Garrett Schmidt: Dean of Students Schmidt commented on Benson Schools wonderful staff and how they have been resilient during these uncertain times; Garrett provided an update on Distance Learning.

6-12, Mike Knutson: Principal Knutson remarked on how flexible and accommodating the staff have been; Mike gave an update on In-Person Learning, Students are spread out six feet or more, Lunch is going smoother, Staff are cleaning, spraying down classrooms and wiping things down; Mike provided an update on devices, Originally the Chromebooks were supposed to arrive late August/early September, Now the estimated timeline to receive Chromebooks is the end of November.

Financial Report, Katie Foley: Business Office staff are getting ready for the audit and single audit.

Superintendent Report, Dennis Laumeier: Supt. Laumeier provided an update on school re-opening, Students and staff are doing a great job, It's great to have students back in school and students are happy to be back; Cleaning staff have done an amazing job; School Nursing staff are working extra hours to keep up with COVID related requirements.

Old Business:

Construction Update: Construction Manager Ryan Breitbach provided a construction and budget update.

Snow Removal Proposal: Maintenance staff proposed the option for the school district to consider purchasing snow removal equipment and having in-house maintenance staff do the snow removal. The board has three options for snow removal: 1) Contract snow removal, 2) Rent snow removal equipment or 3) Purchase snow removal equipment. A discussion was held. Motion by G. Williams, second by B. McGeary to approve purchasing two skidsteer loaders, a bucket and broom attachment not to exceed \$100,000. Motion carried (7-0).

400 Policy Series: This is the second reading on Policies 418, 418FRM, 419, 420, 421, 422, 423, 424, 425, 427 based on changes recommended by MSBA to meet law.

Motion by B. McGeary, second by G. Williams to adopt policies 418, 418FRM, 419, 420, 421, 422, 423, 424, 425, 427 based on changes recommended by MSBA to meet law. Motion carried (7-0).

Superintendent Evaluation Summary: Chair Brian Samuelson read a summary of the year end superintendent evaluation.

2020-2021 Goals: Supt. Laumeier presented the 2020-2021 Board and Superintendent Goals.

Motion by B. McGeary, second by M. KW Langan to approve the Board and Superintendent Goals 2020-2021. Motion carried (7-0).

New Business:

Designation of Identified Official: The Minnesota Department of Education (MDE) requires that school districts annually designate an Identified Official with Authority to comply with the MNIT Enterprise Identity and Access Management Standard which states that all user access rights to Minnesota state systems must be reviewed and recertified at least annually. Motion by M. KW Langan, second by P. Carruth to authorize Superintendent Dennis Laumeier to act as the Identified Official with Authority (IOwA) for Benson Schools, ISD #777. Motion carried (7-0).

Levy Certification: Director of Finance Katie Foley presented the preliminary payable 2021 Levy Certification.

Motion by B. McGeary, second by G. Williams to approve the maximum pay 2021 levy as presented. Motion carried (7-0).

MSHSL Membership Fee: Supt. Laumeier presented the MSHSL increase in membership fees for the 2020-2021 school year. The options are to pay the fee or not pay the fee and not be a member of the MSHSL. The board would like Dennis and Activities Director Garrett Schmidt to reach out to other school districts to see what their plans are regarding the increase in fees.
