To help the kindergarteners learn their sight words, I will be starting a system called "Rainbow Words".

On the back of this paper, you will see a list of "rainbow words"--sight words-- that your child needs to master by the end of the year. Sight words are words that students should "automatically" know when they read them. These are words that students should NOT have to sound out.

Please practice these words at home with your child. Your child will be tested at least once a week at school. Once he/she has mastered the "Red List", your child may start practicing the "Orange List" words. The goal is for all the students to complete the "Purple List" by the end of the school year.
