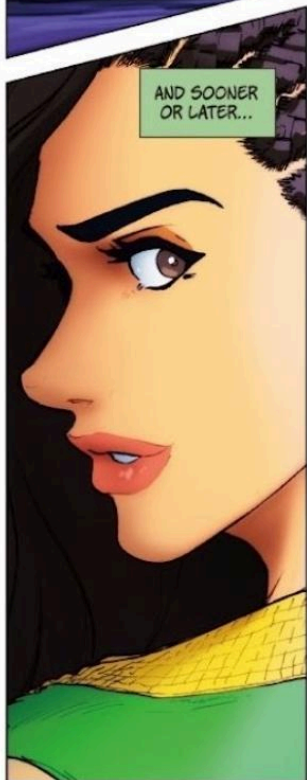
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## Jedah Dohma

Jedah has a feat that is quite interesting in the events of the comics, the creation of the Majigen



Jedah describes the Majigen as a “self contained universe” and a “pocket of Space-time”.  
How big is it truly?  
Beyond containing forest and what seems to be a earth, It actually has stars, at least 2



But, might It be actually a **full fleshed universe** besides being described as a “pocket”?

I think so. But to explain it, I should first start giving the context of where the Majigen was created: **The void**.

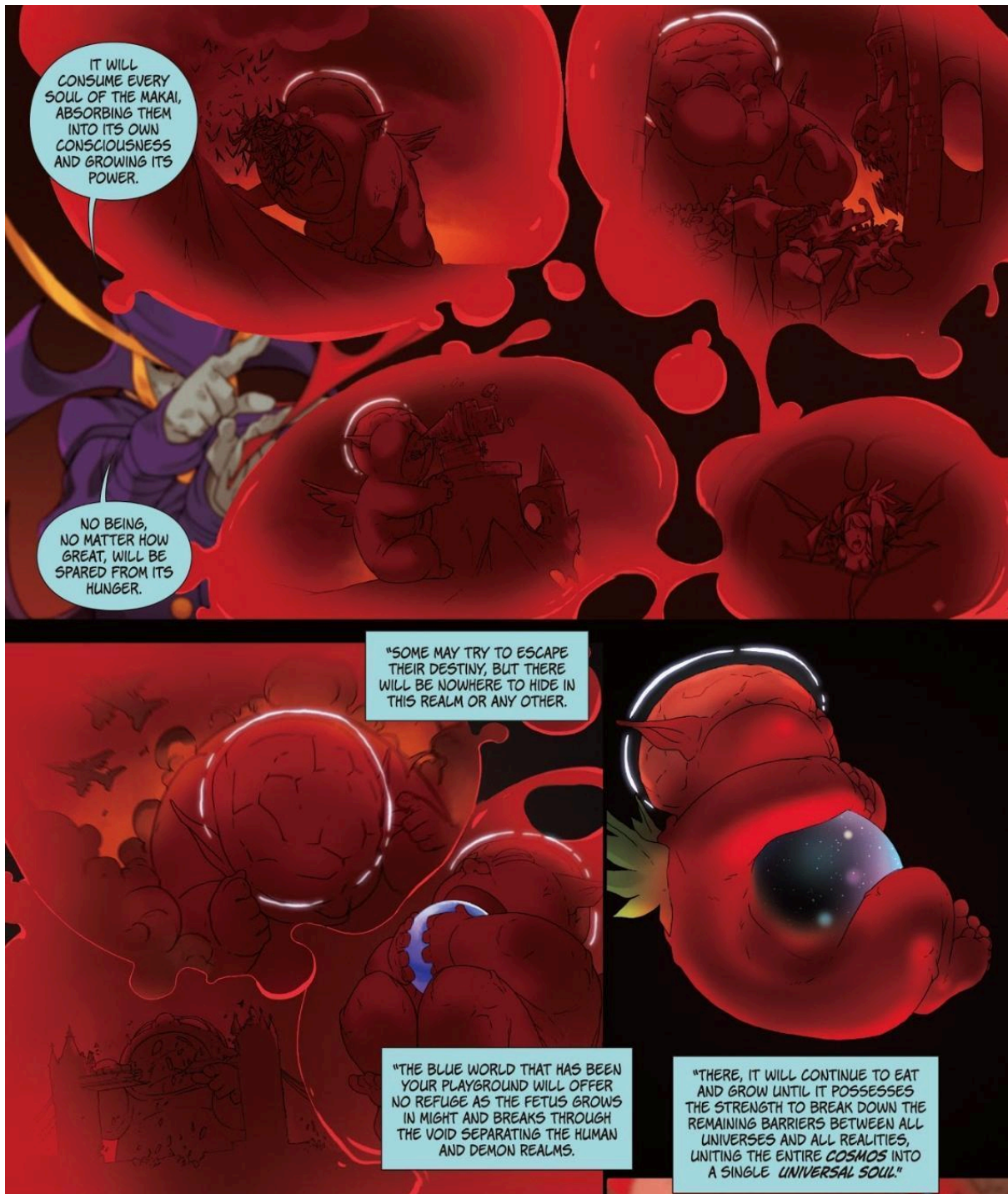

Gen describes the void as a place “outside of time, space, **all planes of reality and beyond the realms.**” so the void is described as something greater than the universes such as the human one or the makai

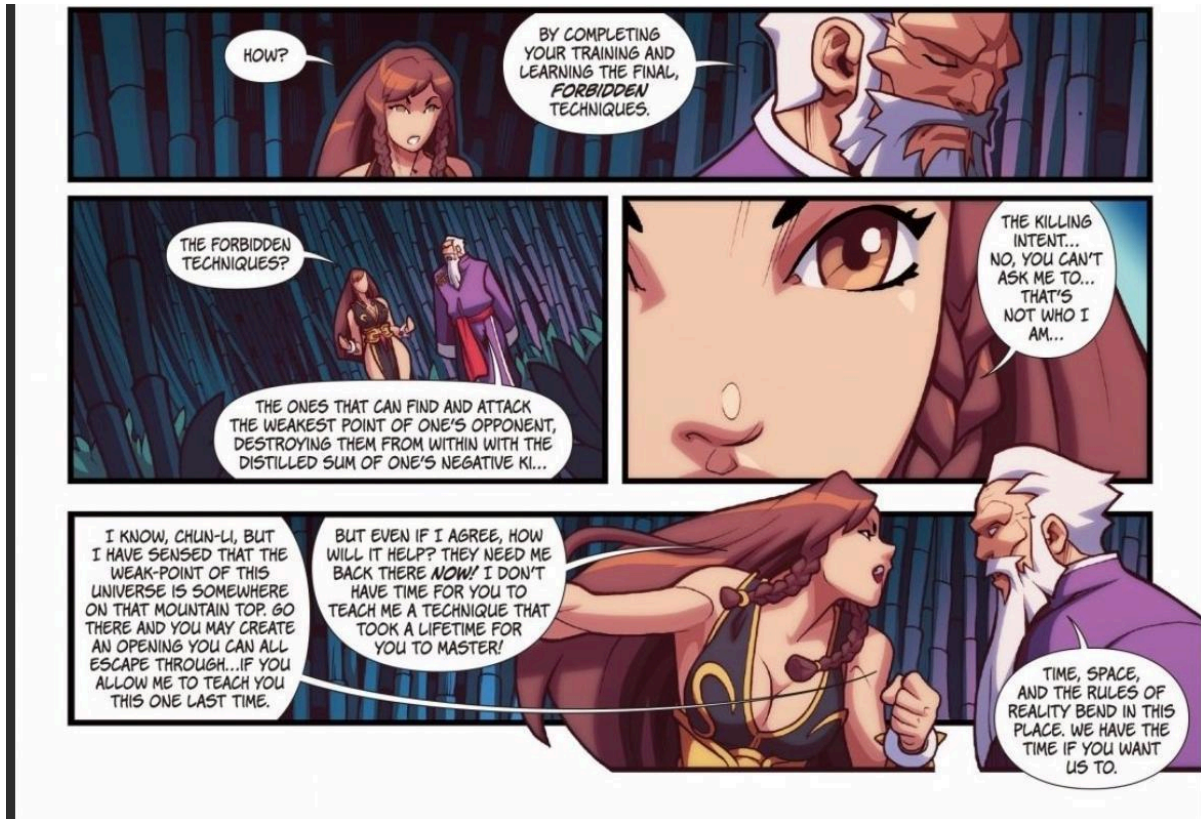


Jedah also describes It as a void between the realms and dimensions



It makes sense because Jedah himself says that once the void is destroyed, all the universes will become one (I won't talk about the general cosmology of Udon/SF because I don't feel that is relevant for today). So, while the void is called a "pocket" and "self

contained”, that’s only because it’s inside a far greater place than a single universe.



Gen also confirms that the Majigen has a time and space of itself that acts differently from the one in the human realm.

**note: It won't make sense for the Majigen to just bend the "normal" space-time since it, once again, was created inside the void. Which has been repeated over and over again to lack a space-time of its own.**

Now, let's talk about why we are reading this.

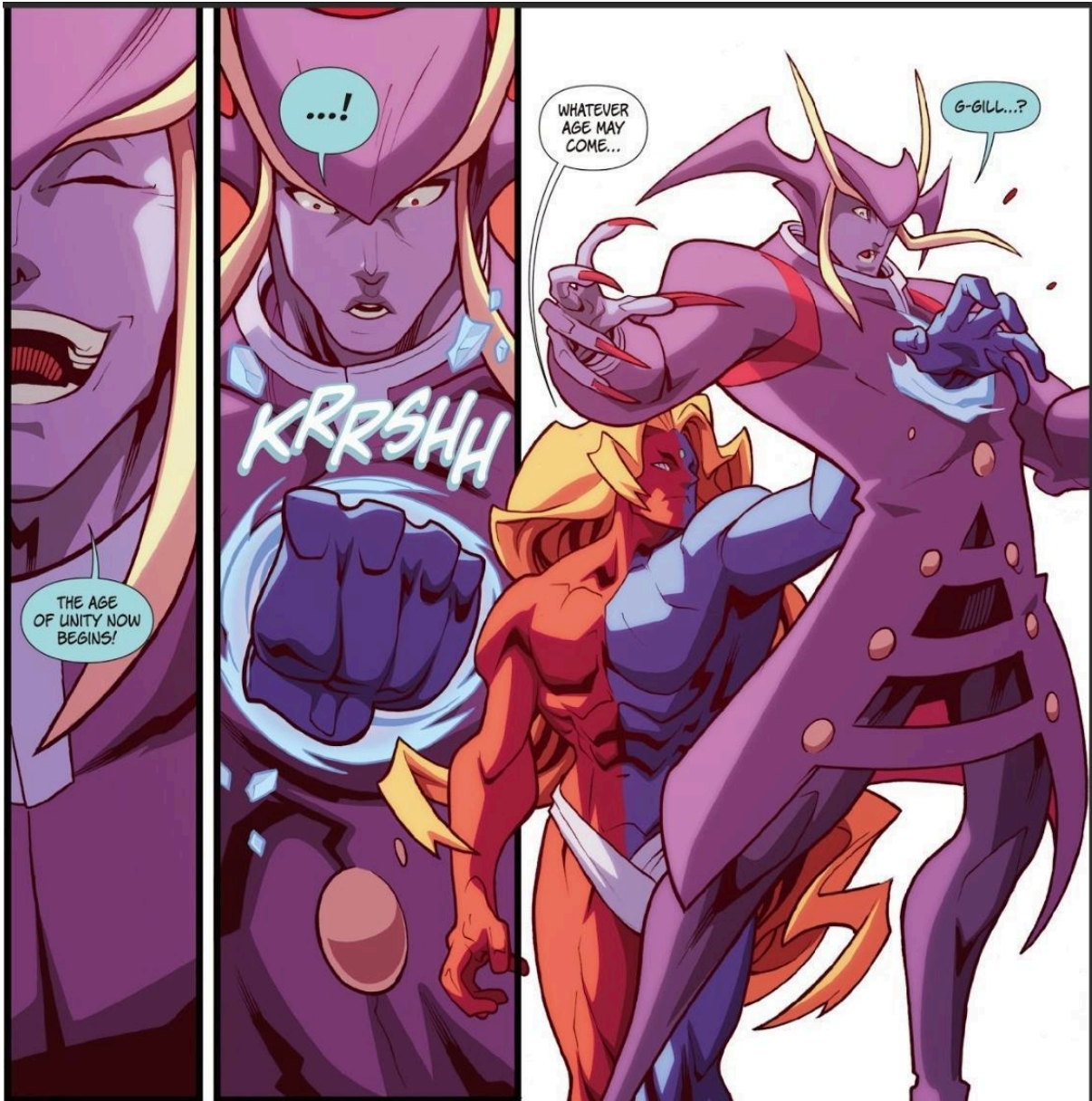

## The scaling

The very first thing, it's obvious that Akuma and other high tier SF characters can harm Jedah fairly easily.





But, there is a **little problem**. It might be possible that Jedah doesn't scale to the whole output of his powers physically (and I would understand if someone doesn't want to do this because the chain scaling might end causing that almost all the verse scales to this). So... Is there a way to scale Akuma and Ryu to that output? Once again, **I think so**.



Akuma can destroy Jedah's Blood attacks and even claim that the Satsui no hado is more powerful than the other forms of KI in the verse... Is this a baseless claim? Is it simply ego? For today, I won't enter into what the Satsui no hado might have done by itself, I'll stick to this which is far more simple. But answering... We must first understand Akuma's connection to the Satsui no hado.

**Note: Akuma is obviously jumping Jedah with the other fighters and Darkstalkers. But this doesn't really mean that he is weaker per se, just that Jedah is incredibly hard to kill due to his immortality. As we've seen, Akuma has no problem overpowering both Jedah's body and power.**



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As shown previously, at the end of Akuma VS Hell, Akuma got thrown into the void by Gen trying to make him "find light". But, this did not work...



YOU WERE WRONG, GEN. THE DAYS, YEARS OR DECADES I SPENT IN THE VAST EMPTINESS BROUGHT ME ENLIGHTENMENT, BUT NOT THE KIND THAT YOU WERE PROFESSING.

FINALLY, THE SATSUI NO HADO AND I ARE NOW ONE!

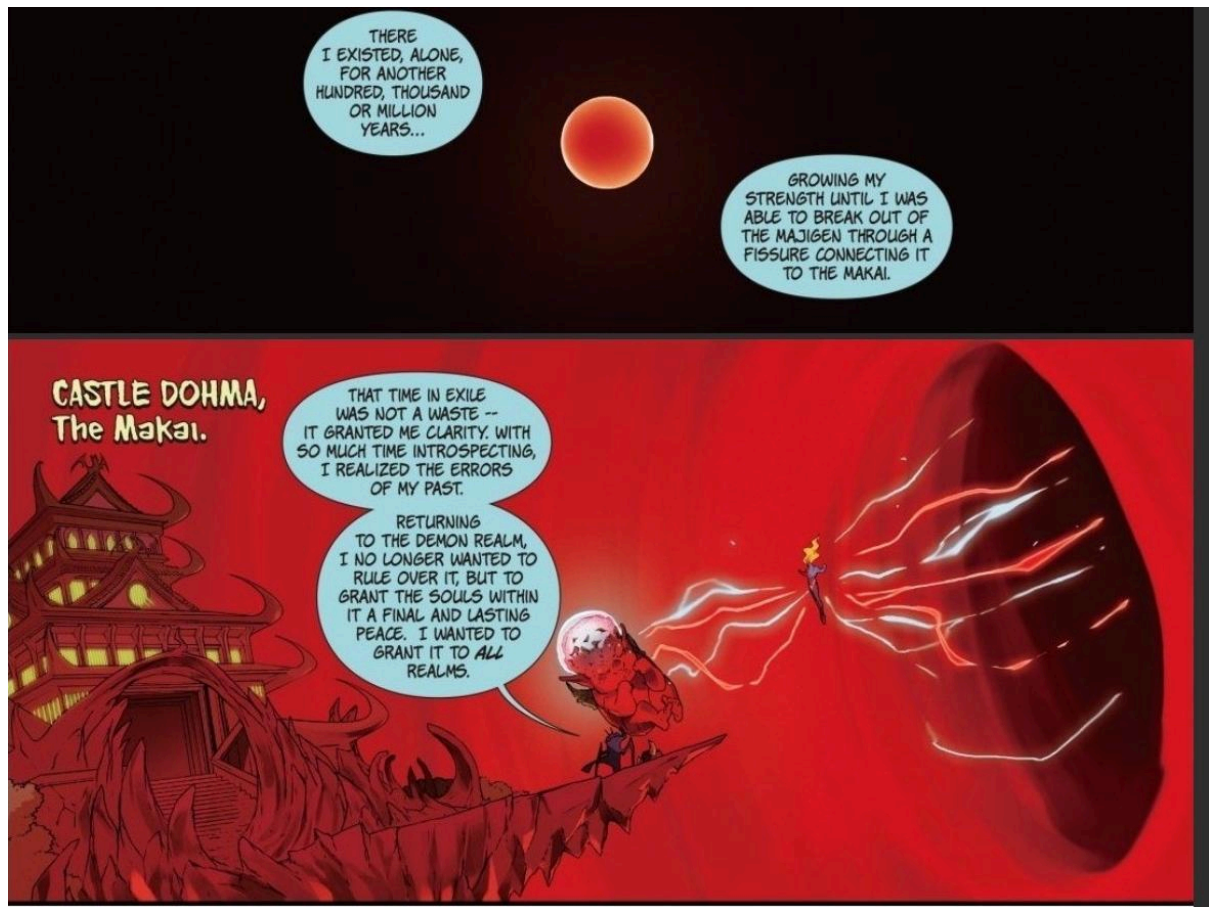
The End.

Not only that, but Akuma himself said that he became one with the Satsui No Hado. So, during his time in the void Akuma developed a deep bond and understanding with this Dark Ki. So, him stating that the Satsui no hado surpasses Jedah might not be a baseless claim.

But on top of that... Akuma did not leave the void as Gen intended.



Akuma did not “enlighten”, so he should find his way out, and there are 2 options, he casually found a fissure... Or he forced his way out. To escape the void, Jedah waited after the creation of the Majigen until he became strong enough to create/use a fissure that connected it to the Makai.



But Akuma should have broken through the void directly if he simply wasn't lucky enough to find a fissure... And is here when we come to the final piece of evidence:

Aaaaand, here it is. In these two pages, Akuma confirms once again that he understands the Satsui no Hado in depth, but the most important part comes from the second page: Ryu and Akuma force their way into the void, creating a fissure when they clash. You already can see where it is going, right? The Jedah that created the Majigen did not have enough output of energy to create a fissure that connected the realms to the void, he had to wait and even then he couldn't really break through the void but only through his own Majigen. But won't make this a shared feat? I mean, yes. But both were at the point blank of all the energy, so they should still scale to it by themselves. And would be consistent with how Akuma escaped the void by himself.

Aaaaand lastly, just to make clean one thing:



Lastly, Gen broke through the void far before Akuma and Ryu did. Does he scale to this? And the answer is a: maaaaaaaaybe(?)

Look, you can make the argument, sure. But Gen was struggling against an Akuma that hadn't "become one" with the Satsui No Hado. And on top of that, there is this...



Gen explains to Chun-li that his teachings would allow her to use a weak point in that universe and escape using it. Chun-li needs to use a specific point to break through the

dimension, but won't be strange if Gen, who has mastered it for years



Even in the panel in which he creates the fissure, it seems to be more of a technique than a display of power. So, yeah, I personally don't buy Gen and other SF characters scaling to all of this for the moment.

If I see interest in this little doc I'll work on a bigger one covering things of **the main canon** that I think are kinda overlooked and giving my personal opinion on its scaling. I hope y'all
