



ACTIVITY ELIGIBILITY/GRADES

Our goal is to provide an environment where students experience a school-wide commitment to high standards of academic excellence and personal behavior. Recognition of superior performance is essential to student growth and development. Equally important is a need for a program to hold students accountable for unsatisfactory performance that will help them gain self-direction and a sense of responsibility. Student accountability programs are being used in middle schools and administrators and teachers are actively involved in the development of consistent procedures to hold students accountable for behavior and academics. In order to represent the school in any capacity beyond participation in the required curriculum, a student must maintain a minimum academic grade average of "C" or better during the quarter immediately preceding the desired participation. If less than a "C" average is achieved, the student will be ineligible to participate in extracurricular activities for the next quarter. A "C" average is a 2.0 GPA. Students receiving a "U" in citizenship may be placed on the StudentAccountability list. Students and parents can verify their eligibility status through Progress Reports, Report Cards and on Powerschool. Office Hours is an intervention/enrichment time during the school day, where students can get help with their academic classes. Students should reach out to their teachers and have conversations with them regarding their academic concerns or challenges that they may be having.
