Dear Mr. Lahoud, Mr. Moser, Mr. Jackson, and Mr. Mills:

We write as concerned residents of Western New York and allies of the Tonawanda Seneca Nation (TSN) who deeply value our region's cultural and ecological riches.

We are pleased that the Genesee County Economic Development Center (GCEDC) Board of Directors has retracted its State Environmental Quality Review (SEQR) and other approvals for Stream's proposed nearly 1 million square foot data center at their ill-fated Science, Technology and Advance Manufacturing Park (STAMP), located in the Town of Alabama, NY. We owe this step back to litigation filed in NY State Supreme Court by the Tonawanda Seneca Nation and Sierra Club on behalf of all Western New Yorkers who value our shared environment. However, we are deeply concerned by GCEDC's assertion that Stream Data Centers has informed them that the company intends to submit a proposal for an even larger data center at STAMP. Stream's first proposal was met with powerful, unanimous opposition from local community members and the Tonawanda Seneca Nation - including nearly 800 written comments, 50 spoken comments made at a public hearing, and countless opinion pieces published in local papers. A proposal for an even larger project would be an insult to the many people who passionately detailed the unsuitability of this site for a data center project.

Locating a data center on Tonawanda Seneca Nation unceded homelands, surrounded by a network of public protected lands and in the middle of a vast complex of thriving, biodiverse wetlands: this is an ecological travesty that also threatens the existence of the Nation.

STAMP is, moreover, a failing boondoggle. GCEDC has vastly scaled back their initial plans for the site as various pieces have proven unfeasible. They have changed course innumerable times following setbacks, environmental disasters, and an [ongoing failure to attract viable tenants](#). We see right through their desperate ploy to attract a data center - which doesn't create jobs and isn't an advanced manufacturing enterprise and therefore does not meet the stated goals for the site.

We suspect GCEDC is trying in vain to shore up its public image and also to secure financing for the unfinished (and non-energized) onsite electrical substation.

Nearly 20 years ago, GCEDC envisioned a mega-industrial park at STAMP. This vision has not been realized and it never will be realized, because the [site was and remains totally unsuited to industrial development](#). In fact, a 2012 NYS Smart Growth study called STAMP “[a poster child for location inefficiency](#).”

The STAMP site is not good for industrial development. But it **is** good as a home to a Haudenosaunee Nation and also to the many beings who inhabit the spectacular surrounding public lands, including the Iroquois National Wildlife Refuge. This place is part of the [Western New York Wildway](#) that supports critical open space connectivity as climate change forces wildlife to migrate. The GCEDC does not see the critical ecological and cultural value of this place. They don't realize that these wetlands, streams and floodplain forests are far more valuable without industrial development compromising their ability to provide clean water and support life.

According to the company website, Stream Data Centers is committed to “environmental sustainability, social responsibility, and long-term stewardship.” If that is the case, you must not submit another proposal to build a mega data center at STAMP. Instead, use your leverage to help the GCEDC understand the true value of the lands and waters in Genesee County. That is what we mean when we say “Rethink STAMP.” We invite you to join us.
