- Teacher's conference was successful – Peppers jack was popular. Outdoor Movie Night: rescheduled for April 22, 2022 (Earth Day). We will be watching the movie Lorax and it ties with the Earth Day theme.
- Celebrated valentine's day in class and was very successful.

V. New Business

- **Administration Report: Ms. Ciarapica**
 - Thanked the PTA for the Pepper Jacks – staff enjoyed the treat and appreciated the support for small businesses in the area.
 - Re- Valentine's day celebration - Apple slices scarcity is noted for future celebrations in school.
 - End of year activities – we can't have people in school during school activities due to covid-19 verification process but can have people in

the building after school hours. End of year celebrations cannot be in the school building

- May 12, 5th grade kids will visit the middle school in person.
- May 19 Typical field day outside.

K-3 chromebooks are being kept at school to reduce the wear and tear. 3rd grade use technology for homework and the school will work with them on implementing use. Families are encouraged to monitor use of the Chromebook for academic use instead of recreation use.
- Typical Peer Conflict – we're starting to see typical peer conflict which are common as they interact with each other in the spring. If you get a call from the school, it's okay. The school is working with families to find lasting solutions. Learning behaviors is a continuum.
- Mask Mandate – 75% of staff still wearing masks, kids are using it 50%. Grateful that the kids are respectful of other's choices.
