Wayne County 4-H Horse and Pony (WCHP)

REGISTRATION

Registration will be held at the May WCHP meeting at 6:00 p.m. (held the third Tuesday every month), at the Wayne County Fairgrounds prior to testing and interviewing in the Dining Hall. Contestants must complete all four components of the program in order to receive recognition. Results will be announced during the rules meeting at 7:00 p.m. on Sunday before the Wayne County Fair officially begins. Age determination for Junior or Senior is as of January 1, of the current year. Junior Senior 14 years and under 14 years and over

PROGRAM COMPONENTS

Test (possible 100 points)

The test questions will be taken from the 4-H Horse Science and Horsemanship books and could consist of true / false, matching, multiple choice or fill in the blank. Will be pointed by percent correct.

Interview (possible 100 points)

Interviewee will be judged on appearance (interview attire), self presentation, the ability to give a brief overview of their 4-H experience.

Junior Executive Board Meeting

As a program participant, you will receive 5 points for each Jr. Executive Board meeting attended in March, April, May, June and July. You must attend at least one Junior Executive Board meeting. Meetings will be held at 6:00 p.m. prior to the WCHP meetings. Be sure to sign the sign-in sheet!

Performance Contestants (possible 120 points)

Participant will compete in four classes (Showmanship, Equitation/Horsemanship, Trail and Barrels) in their respective age groups at Learner's Day (be sure to register your classes on the Learner's Day Registration form). Trail and Barrels will be placed based on the scoring of original age group run. Points will be awarded as following 30/1st, 25/2nd, 20/3rd, 15/4th, 10/5th and 5/6th. Results will be held until awards are presented at the Wayne County Fair. Contestants must show their WCHP registered horse or pony project.
