STANDARDS & ASSESSMENT

- Final Testing Calendar for 24-25
- ATLAS
 - K-2 and Grade 3 Screener <u>latest slides here</u> (8/13/24). The test will now open August 28th for schools and testing must be completed by September 27th (30 days). Results will not be released to schools until October 14th, because standard setting must take

place based on student data from the beginning of the year. Testlets will also be released for students who flag on the screener.

o READING/ELA

- RISE dates have not yet been scheduled. At this time, it doesn't appear there is enough need for us to offer them. If this changes, we will let you know.
- Stand-alone SoR dates have been scheduled. Attending all three days + having Awareness (usually IDEAS videos) make Pathway D for teachers needing a Phase I pathway.
 - Friday, September 27 --- Decoding
 - Wednesday, October 30 --- Morphology
 - Wednesday, November 20 --- Content Area Reading

o MATH

- K-2 ATLAS Math: Students in K-2 will take ATLAS Math for the first time this year.
 - Screener: There will be a screener in the beginning of the year that will focus
 on number sense and is meant to check for grade level readiness. The text
 will be fixed form and will flag students who need further testing in key skills
 using testlets.
 - A suggested math intervention plan for K-2 is being developed now by DESE. This is not required by law as it is for 3-8, but is recommended.
 - Interim and Summative: They will also have a winter interim and a summative test in the spring to determine progress on grade level standards in math. Both the interim and summative will be adaptive, just like the 3-10 ATLAS..

NOVICE TEACHER MENTORING

- Arkansas Novice Teacher State Mentoring Manual
- Novice teachers are individuals with less than 3 years of total student-facing teaching experience as determined by the following criteria:
 - Assigned to certain 6-digit course codes in eSchool or job codes in eFinance requiring a license or involving a class taught for concurrent credit
 - Reported by district in eFinance as having 0, 1, or 2 years of total teaching experience
 - The "Years in Total" field does not affect the years of service toward retirement as collected by the Arkansas Teacher Retirement System.
- Lead/Master Teacher Designation Chart This is a chart created by the South Central

Co-op that lists all the pathways that are currently approved for Lead and Master designation.

- Late Hire Dates for Year One Teachers
 -these dates are for any first year teacher
 (except for those in the North Little Rock School District and the Conway School
 District) who was unable to attend the annual Novice Institute that was held on
 August 1 and 2.
 - Day One: September 24, 2024
 - Day Two: October 2, 2024
- ALL novice teachers in years 1-3 MUST be assigned a support person by the principal. The district's point of contact will share a spreadsheet for principals to enter this information and to verify their novice teachers. (p.7 in the Arkansas Novice Teacher State Mentoring Manual)
 - Novice Teacher Support Person Guidelines
