

# Reading With Paper ELA, Grades K-8

### **Assignment Objectives**

- Students will be able to read with appropriate accuracy, fluency and correct intonation.
- The Live Help feature will be utilized for this activity.

#### **Teacher Instructions**

- Walk students through how to send pictures and record voice notes during a Live Help session.
- Assign a reading passage or short story to your students.
- Ensure your students have a quiet space or headset to practice their reading with a Paper tutor.
- Provide your students with the sheet below to guide them through the steps.
- (Optional) Give students a specific length of time you would like them to practice for.

- Assign for reading homework
- As a center or station activity
- During reading small groups
- Independent reading time



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## **Reading With Paper**

#### **Student Instructions**

- 1. Log in to Paper and start a Live Help session by choosing your English Language Arts tile then "Chat with a tutor".
- 2. Choose the "Voice" option to talk with a tutor.
- 3. Click on the camera and take a photo of your reading passage, then send it to your tutor.

\*If you are reading a book, take a picture of, and read, one page at a time.

- 4. Click on the microphone. Read your passage out-loud. Click the "Confirm" button when you are finished reading.
- 5. Send the voice note to your tutor.
- 6. Wait for your tutor to send you feedback on your reading. Listen to the message your tutor sent back to you!
- 7. Fill out the information below.
