Dear CCS family community,

We know it is only June and that school has just been dismissed for the summer, but we also know that some keen families will soon start thinking ahead about school supplies for September! With that in mind, please read the information below to see how school supplies will be handled for your child's grade.

***We understand that the cost of school supplies may present challenges for some of our families. Please don't hesitate to reach out to us at the school in late August/early September if your family requires assistance with the cost of supplies.*

Kindergarten to Grade 5 Students:

Teachers will once again purchase/provide the necessary school supplies and school planners (or back and forth bags) to primary (kindergarten to grade 5) students. Our goal of using this system is to be more cost efficient and less wasteful with our supplies, while still providing teachers with the supplies that they need.

Each K-5 student's family will be asked to provide \$50 for school supplies payable to Cumberland Community School.

Grade 6:

For Grade 6 at CCS, our Teachers will purchase the School Supplies for this Grade.

In September, each Gr 6 student's family will be asked to provide \$40 for school supplies. Each individual grade 6 teacher may request students/families buy a small number of class specific additional supplies in the fall.

**Payments for grades K-6 supplies can be made by cash, cheque, or e-transfer (ccs@sd71.bc.ca)*. If paying by e-transfer, please provide a note including your child's name and "school supplies".*

Grade 7 to 9 Students:

Our teaching from each grade have been asked to develop a "core list" of supplies that they believe all students will need in each specific grade (7-9) next year. Families will be asked to purchase these "core supplies" in one of 2 ways:

METHOD #1: Using Teacher's File quick and easy online ordering service (preferred by teachers), noting there is a \$5 late fee for orders placed after July 15th:

1. Please visit the Teacher's File website by using the following link: <https://packs.teachersfile.ca/schools/85>
2. Select the "Online Form" for the grade that your student **will be attending** at CCS for the 2026-27 school year. You will find Teacher's File has already created the exact list of core supplies that your student will need for their upcoming year at CCS. Scroll down to the "Student Information" section, fill in the information, and then select "Order and Begin Checkout". You will be given a choice/explanation of payment options at checkout.
3. Teacher's File will deliver an individualized parcel of supplies to each student whose family orders supplies in this way. Your student will receive their parcel of supplies on the first day of school.

METHOD #2: Shopping for their own school supplies:

Parents may also choose to purchase their grade 6-9 student's supplies by themselves. Please use the form on the reverse side of this sheet as your purchase supply list.
