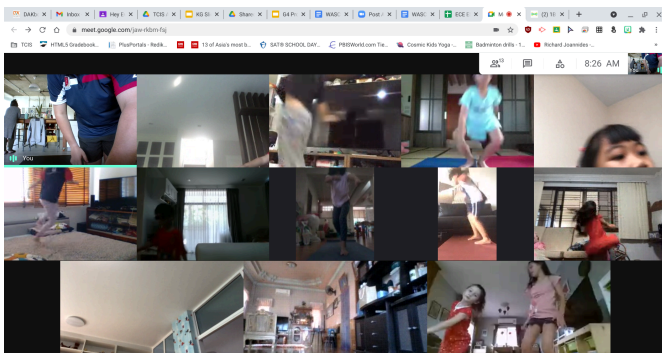
Hello Parents,

In SEL we have been talking about happiness. Ask your students about the places and objects that make them happen. This week we will be talking about the people in our lives that make us happy.

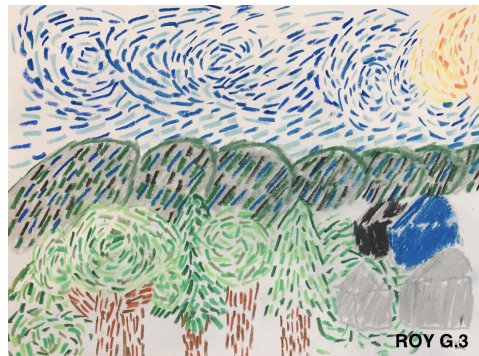
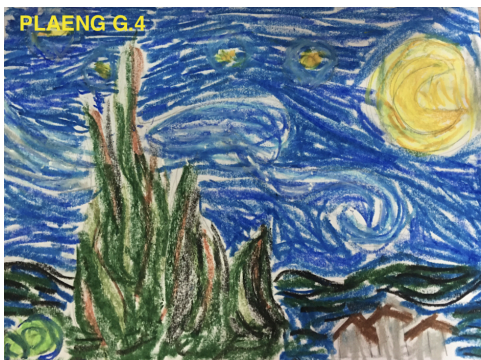
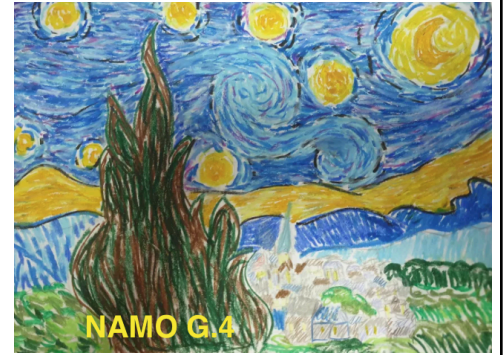
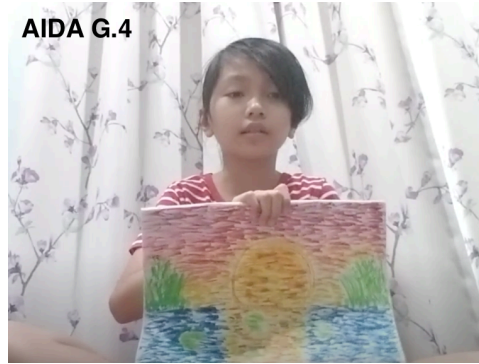

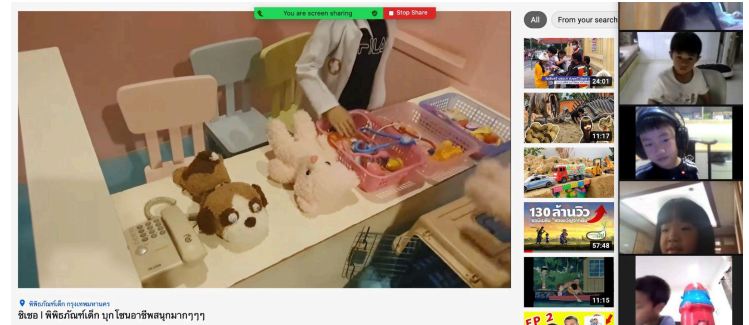
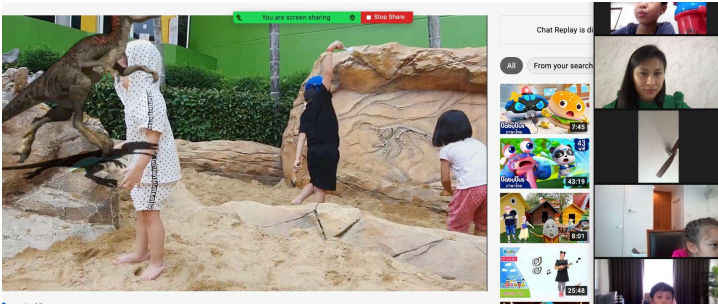
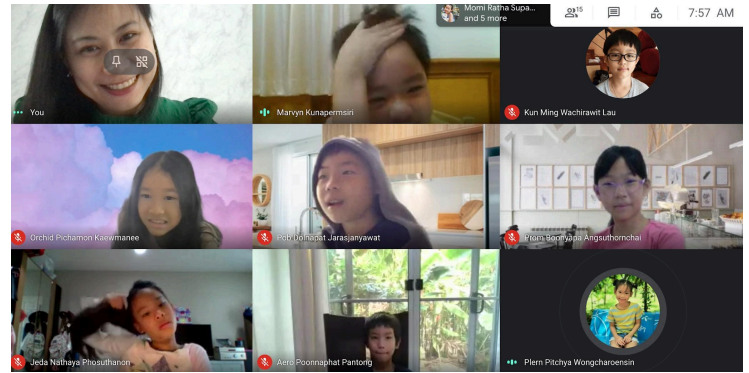
Thai Online classes with Kru Fai

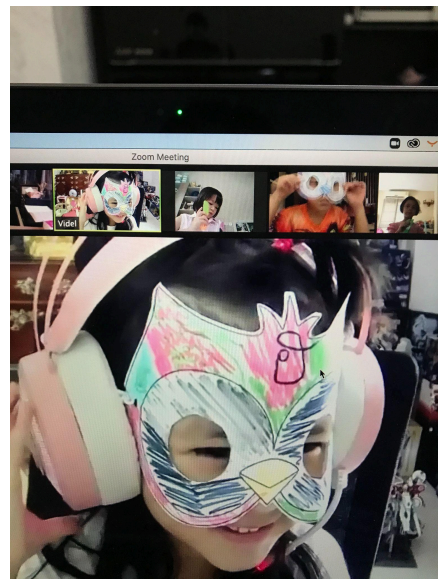
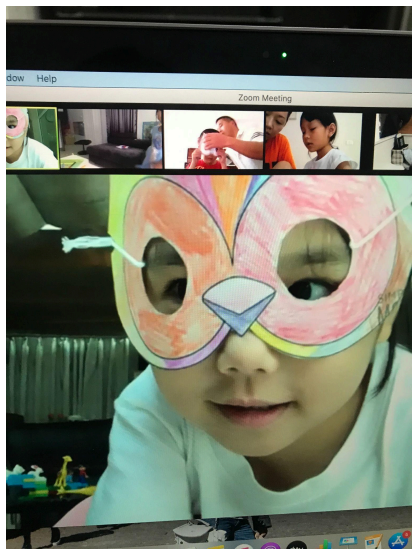
