



PK3 with Ms. Belle made a beautiful butterfly made with their own hands. This craft is so fun! It helped us develop our creativity and improved our fine motor skills.







KGB STEM CHALLENGE is to build a Paper Tower that is stable enough to remain standing up to 20 counts.


Thai Online classes with Kru Fai


