COVID-19 Like Symptoms

Illinois Department of Public Health (IDPH) has recently updated the student and staff exclusionary guidelines and there are three (3) symptoms that are no longer considered "COVID-19 like symptoms" and are no longer a means for school exclusion. As a result, we have updated the student self-certification pads to reflect the updated guidelines. New self-certification pads will be sent home during the week of April 5th. Families who have a student returning to school on April 12th will be mailed the self-certification pad and car-rider yellow sign during the week of April 5th.
