Copy: "Alert! Higher penalties to be enforced this winter for parking violations in the Cottonwood Canyons. The previous fine was \$25, the fines now range from \$75 to \$150.

This new ordinance will go into effect on November 1.

Violations include:

⊘ Parking outside the white line

- ⊘ Parking in a NO PARKING zone (look out for the NO PARKING signs)
- ⊘ Parking in avalanche zones

This is one step to protect safety and keep traffic flowing.

Parking is still allowed in designated areas. This increase in fines does not change the places where parking is allowed. [Tag: UPD, UDOTCottonwoods and SLCoCouncil]"
