

Note that *all* threads with NPCs provide extra interesting information garnered from personal conversations had between PCs and the NPCs. For the juiciest information it's recommended you read the conversations yourselves. The same is also true of Malnosso posts, less so of threads on mission logs between PCs, but those still are usually sort of cool.

Timeline Notes interspacing the major events include all major plot-related happenings, village-wide events which are not Shifts (though it might be good to add those as well), and all posts on lucetilocked, as those are often plot-relevant as well.

001: [Third Party Observation](#) (February 5th - 10th)

- *PCs Involved:* Luke Skywalker, Ami Mizuno, Sheena Fujibayashi, Gambit, Chien* Tenenbro*, and Hamato Leonardo*
- *NPCs Involved:* No named ones
- Some details about third party's language discovered - metaphorical to the point of nonsense. This would later be substantiated in the ongoing Ruins Exploration missions.

(TIMELINE NOTE: [Ginia summarizes the Town Meeting](#) on February 10th)

(TIMELINE NOTE: [Albert gives his Update](#) on February 20th)

002: [Desert Survey](#) (February 21st - 26th)

- *PCs Involved:* Daisy, Haruhi Suzumiya, Mega Man*, Cho Hakkai*, Aether*, Amelia*, Ginia*, and Saber*
- *NPCs Involved:* No named ones
- The sky in barriers with stars implied to be created by a Shift (later confirmed in Space Draft - there are no real stars)
- The mission goers were given an option of three routes, each with a different possible result. It was chosen to go East and to a droid facility.
- Some details about the droids discovered ([see here](#)), most notably their vulnerability to Shifting. Nothing was able to be brought back other than memories though.
- As a result of choosing a route which didn't go to him, the NPC Jacob was sacrificed and permanently killed (again) by the Third Party (<-- UNKNOWN to anyone in Luceti)

003: [Deep Sea Salvage](#) (March 6th - 8th)

- *PCs Involved:* Fujiko Mine*, Bulma Brief*, Ventus, Walter, OoT!Link*, and Aqua*

- *NPCs Involved:* No named ones
- The mission here takes place in the same underwater facility (now defunct) where a previous [draft](#) took place
- Details about how Malnosso facilities are run, but nothing of much note other than the model village being a component of repair shifts
- First glimpse of codes about experiment readings possibly seen (NOT THREADED)

004: [Third Floor Revisited](#) (March 22nd- 23rd)

- *PCs Involved:* Nara Shikamaru, Tony Stark, Mia, Tear, Melaka*, Sheik*, Kazooie*, Freyjadour, Caius*, Joshua Bright*, Jubei*, and Leonhardt*
- *NPCs Involved:* Davis (no thread), unnamed scientist
- First log to feature Davis
- This log refers to the [Third Floor Monster](#) (warning, Lj link) discovered during an old infiltration plot
- Some more details about the creature from the Third Floor introduced (nothing concrete)
- A bomb was introduced capable of sending the creature back to its own world. *PCs* were advised not to get any funny ideas, because its world isn't a place anyone would want to go to
- Davis thought it was a suicide mission and was surprised they pulled it off

(TIMELINE NOTE: [Bil left comatose and Molly kidnapped](#) on March 26th, also serves as first introduction of the new model of droids)

(TIMELINE NOTE: [Day in Another World](#) happens April 1st, the AU event caused by re-anchoring happens after this from April 2nd - 8th)

(TIMELINE NOTE: [ANI contacts village about errors](#) on April 8th, marking the first Shift which did not wear off properly on top for Lucetians)

005: [Cargo Run](#) (April 17th - 21st)

- *PCs Involved:* Trafalgar Law, Sanji*, Azusa Miura*, Adele LeBlanc, Hulk*, Daisy, Anakin Skywalker*, Asbel Lhant, Buffy Summers, Arsene Lupin III*, Selphie Tilmitt, James Norrington, Mikage Celestine*, Rogue, Nami**, and Kurt Wagner**
- *NPCs Involved:* Davis ([thread](#)), Third Party, MSF soldiers, mission-goers from other enclosures
- MSF stands for "Malnosso Security Forces," and are the Malnosso's military
- Introduction to the term "Sparties" to refer to the Third Party
- The ship they were on was named *Tyr's Revenge*
- Second(?) coming of the kraken to attack the ship

006: [Defense of Segretar](#) (May 15th - 17th)

- *PCs Involved:* Adell*, Helios, Daisy, Homura*, Saten, Leonhardt*, Goku (DBZ)*, Luffy*, and Aether*
- *NPCs Involved:* Davis (no thread), Third Party, MSF soldiers, Segretar residents
- The village layout of Segretar was almost identical to Luceti except smaller

- New type of Third Party Shifter introduced: can copy the superpowers of people within a hundred meters of them
- First time Luceti residents were in an enclosure other than their own (though members of other enclosures had been met on missions and drafts before this)

007: [The Flooded Valley](#) (June 7th - 9th)

- *PCs Involved*: Obi-Wan Kenobi*, Gai Tsutsugami, Rick Doyle*, Arthur Pendragon*, Raven, Clove, Rei Hino, Gregor Vorbarra*, Minato Arisato*, Sabriel Abhorsen*, Minako Arisato*, Grune, Gold, Masaomi Kida, Fenimore, Silver*, Adele LeBlanc, Sion, Raine Sage, Nami**, Leonardo*, Viral*, Smoker, Precis F. Neumann*, Roy*, Nara Shikamaru, Hyuuga Neji, and Kiba Inuzuka
- *NPCs Involved*: Davis (no thread), Third Party, MSF soldiers, refugees
- Some things overheard from the people being rescued ([thread](#))
- Introduction to the term “baskers” to refer to the Shift Hunters
- This mission was the first to involve civilians (the refugees), who were staying at the resort. While some worked for the Malnosso, it was odd jobs like dentist.

XX1: [Defense of Bil](#) (Given own Subheading due to Complexity)

- [Ultimatum about Bil](#) given on June 12th
- [Town Meeting](#) about Bil's defense on June 13th
- [John is consulted](#) on June 13th - after the Town Meeting - and asks Rin to recruit Albert, Shikamaru, and Law to meet with him. This meeting is mostly assumed, but he helps them make their existing plan function.
- [CJ announces Space Draft](#) June 17th
- [Space Draft](#) - two logs - is June 19th - 23rd
 - The Space Draft featured NPC threads with both [Davis](#) and the [General](#). The Commandant (no thread) was also there.
 - New type of Third Party Shifter introduced: the Dream Shifters
 - The Malnosso have ventured into space, but nothing seems to exist besides the sun and a few other planets. They maintain a base on the Moon, primarily for Shift research. Conceptually it seems similar to the Underwater Base.
 - The Malnosso have three large space worthy vessels, all three of which appear to be very old. The Luceti draftees are on the *Liberator* going to the moon.
 - The cultists have the means to travel into space and don't seem to require air.
 - The first draft where Luceti combatants cooperated with the MSF and draftees from other enclosures.
- [Village Invasion](#) is June 21st -23rd
- [Decoy team infiltrates Rogue facility](#) on June 22nd-23rd
 - Team consists of Shikamaru, Lupin*, Sheena, and Lestrade*
 - Some mallynapped victims, mainly those from other enclosures, were being experimented on in this facility. Many were temporarily freed and joined the team for the following.

- Droid factory is discovered on the third floor of that building, including the new model which have actual brains installed in their skulls
- An administrator is overheard ordering his “niece” (later confirmed to be Molly) be transported out of the city. (This is heard only by Lupin, but later relayed to Shikamaru (Lupin also directly relayed this information to Trafalgar Law and a few other residents that seemed relevant.))
- The village attack is called off, and the administrator implies Bil will be a greater threat to them by dying, and that they should make plans for his rebirth.
- Decoy team shuts down the power to the building. This was intended to take the droids offline, but takes the repairing shifts in Luceti out as well. The new model of droids were not affected by this.
- Lupin is killed on the mission (after the bit about Bil is overheard) Shikamaru, Sheena, and Lestrade* all are returned to Luceti at different times.
- [Bil dies](#) June 23rd before draftees are back
 - Trafalgar Law requests help in dealing with the droids as a ‘gift’.
- Decoy team relay their findings ICly on [lucetilocked](#) on July 2nd

008: [Railway Rescue](#) (July 23rd - 25th)

- *PCs Involved:* Naoi, Claude C. Kenny*, Rock Lee, Caius Qualls*, Gai Tsutsugami, Luke fon Fabre, Zevran*, William Bush*, Nara Shikamaru, Susan Richards*, Estelle*, Scully*, Mia, Howard Stark*, Tony Stark, Mikado Ryugamine*
- *NPCs Involved:* Molly ([thread](#)), unnamed woman
- First official mission against the efforts of the Rogue Faction.
- Molly was rescued from the train and handed off to an unknown presumably allied (to Bil, that is) Malnosso group.

(TIMELINE NOTE: [Count Zompano contacts Luceti again](#) July 29th)

(TIMELINE NOTE: Topsy-Turvy Experiment happens July 30th - August 4th.

During it, [rumors](#) are spread by the trees about the NPCs. Half of these are true)

009: [Festival at Rataneran Keep](#) // S01: A Necessary Sacrifice (August 17th - 18th)

- *PCs Involved:* Jack Sparrow, Pao-Lin*, Gambit, Buffy, Maron Kusakabe, Raine Sage, Albert Silverberg, Trafalgar Law, Nefeteri Vivi*, Rogue, Pepper Potts, Cloche, Temperance Brennan*, Norma Beatty, Raven, Grune, Sokka, Kiba Inuzuka, Eusine*, Peeta Mellark*, Yamanaka Ino, Jiro Kusano*, Rainbow Dash, Steve Rogers, Booth, Joshua Bright*, Leonhardt*, Syre Atries*
- *NPCs Involved:* Count Zompano (no thread), CJ ([thread](#)), Janice (offscreen), Davis ([thread](#)), Zompano’s servants and security, various performers
- First “Secret Mission” - Leonhardt, Joshua Bright, and Syre were assigned as assassins for Zompano while the others were supposedly gathering information. Joshua failed, Syre was killed, but Leonhardt succeeded ([thread](#)) so Zompano is sacrificed and thus is permanently dead in theory
- The performers were there because of a Malnosso holiday called Founder’s Day and the

Luceti people were assuming the role of a travelling circus called the Feathered Phenomenals.

- Some things were likely [overheard](#) from various people at the celebration.
- In the course of the act, the Lucetians performed a [play](#) which may or may not give some information on the early days of the Organization.

XX2: Kin'coran Refugees in Luceti (Given own Subheading due to Complexity)

- [Malnosso announce that refugees are coming](#) on August 25th
- The [Kin'corans in Luceti](#) August 25th - 31st
 - As the affair with the Kin'corans was a major event, the full details of it are not self-contained to the main Mass-Log. There are other posts and logs associated with the event not listed here because they are not necessarily plot relevant.
 - Snippets from the Kin'corans can be read [here](#) and a spreadsheet of Kin'corans is [here](#). The Kin'corans had their own [timeline of events](#) for their enclosure, some of which they may have shared.
- [Minato appeals to Luceti's Humanity](#) on lucetiocked, August 26th
- On August 29th, Korras Blake's posse committed numerous raids around Luceti
 - [The Farm](#) was raided in the relatively early morning
 - [The Smithy](#) was raided thirty minutes after the farm
 - [Cloud Nine](#) was raided later that night
- [Rem contacts village again](#) August 29th - after at least the first two raids - to ask people to talk to Blake and tough it out a few more days
- On August 30th, two groups had meetings with Korras Blake
 - [Daisy](#) met with him first
 - [Shikamaru and Masaomi](#) met with him second, entering negotiations and giving him droid schematics
- The Kin'corans left (with some droid assistance) on August 31st

(TIMELINE NOTE: [Misconceptions Post](#) run by Alexei and Nephry on lucetilocked, September 1st)

010: Operation: Hospital Freedom (September 3rd - 4th)

- *PCs Involved:* Gai Tsutsugami, Faith*, Amelia*, Hyuuga Neji, Masaomi Kida, Nara Shikamaru, Edward Elric, Susan Richards*, Precis F. Neumann*, Katara, Rock Lee, Gregor Vorbarra*, Tarrlok*, Nephry Osborne
- *NPCs Involved:* Davis ([thread](#)), Carol (hidden), Kovan Foster ([thread](#)), Foster's [key underlings](#), other MSF rogues, patients and doctors held hostage
- NOTE: No one could overhear the conversation between Carol and Davis
- Davis implies he was once in the Luceti enclosure (later confirmed)
- Neji and Shikamaru found some stuff in the [archives](#). (Information found here becomes relevant after Precis finds the new tunnels)
- "Death Penalty Syndrome" discovered - people who have died enough times in this world and gotten enough death penalties so as to be vegetables.

- The mission also serves as a symbolic point about how people born in this world (who eventually grow big wings) will tend to descend into madness and get closer to the Third Party's ideology.
- Overall, the mission clarifies a lot about cycles of life and death in the world. Many of Foster's men have been through more than one life cycle and it's now proved that no one except John can cure Death Penalties - people on the outside live with them.
- Ranks within the MSF are explored. Most of them reflect a business-structure, with managers or foremen in place of ranks like captain and lieutenant. A key point among Kovan's men is the diversity of the soldiers, in terms of species, gender, age, and wing size. Soldiers seemingly must ascend the ranks again with each life cycle.
- Precis ended up taking the Shift Bomb that Foster had ([details about bomb here](#)) had and in attempting to disarm it ended up dying. But because she took it to a room that nullified the shift, it saved all the other PCs and most NPCs on the mission
- Clarification of the term "lucies," previously mentioned in the Festival Mission. The actual meaning would come up again on the glossary the next mission (Neji saw the term used in graffiti and relayed it to Shikamaru.)

(TIMELINE NOTE: [Katara urges humanity](#) and checks a few other facts as well on lucetilocked, Septmber 9th)

(TIMELINE NOTE: [Masaomi alerts people to Droid Sabotage mission](#) on September 13th)

(TIMELINE NOTE: [Precis receives gift from Davis for sacrifice](#), September 16th)

(TIMELINE NOTE: [Precis and Cheria discover new tunnel spot](#), locked with a code-based lock, on September 18th)

011: [Droid Sabotage](#) (September 21st - 23rd)

- *PCs Involved:* Steve Rogers, Alia Shepard*, Sophie*, Rogue, Greg Lestrade*, Gai Tsutsugami, Masaomi Kida, Leonhardt*, Trafalgar Law, Fujiko Mine*, Nara Shikamaru, Albert Silverberg, Loki, Donatello, Artemis Fowl II*, Daisy, Tony Stark, Robert Hastings, Pascal*, Doctor Eggman*, Raine Sage
- *NPCs Involved:* Rem ([thread](#)), Bil (offscreen), Thoxus Brinn (no thread), The Eighteenth (no thread), Foreman Zapha (no thread), Chief Programmer Kidston (no thread), J.J. Kelms (no thread), Pollock (no thread), Rogue Malnosso scientists and security, resort security, Enclosure-Con goers, the FTSA
- NOTE: Most of Rem and Bil's conversation over the phone can't have been overheard by the Luceti mission-goers.
- FTSA stands for "Free the Test Subjects Association" and details about them can be seen in the mission's glossary for the post body
- Things about the Rogue Malnosso's security, bases, and droids were learned in the course of this mission. The droids were also sabotaged successfully by the scientists on the mission.
- Significant things about the world outside the barrier were learned in the course of the missions. Consult the glossary in the main body of the post to see them

- The FTSA was met in person by the decoy team (Leonhardt, Shikamaru, Masaomi, Fujiko, and Gai) and then worked closely with by the Con Team of the Decoy Team. Details about what they might have learned are noted [here](#).

(TIMELINE NOTE: New tunnel [announced](#) and [explored](#) on October 10th)

(TIMELINE NOTE: [Molly contacts village](#), living in it again on October 12th)

XX3: Battle of Vaskoth (Given own Subheading due to Complexity)

- [Draft Announced](#) (by the Commandant) at 4 AM on October 25th
 - Markedly, the first [100% successful](#) resistance of the droids happens then they are sent to retrieve Ikki. This marks the first IC proof that the Droid Sabotage mission was successful.
- [First half of Draft](#) lasts from October 25th - October 28th
 - [NPC Spreadsheet](#) introduced. This covers NPCs in the MSF, the ones from Kin'cora, and ones from three newly introduced Enclosures: Vaskoth (wherein the draft takes place), Zompania, and Excenn.
 - NPC Threads: [Davis](#) and [Carol](#). Korras Blake is also present but has no thread
 - Two MSF troops from the Hospital missions (Jewel and Brutacus) are present at the battle as well, apparently rehabilitated but on probation.
 - The Draft is hijacked by the introduction and spread of a virus that produces zombie-like symptoms. This virus was actually introduced in the history of Kin'cora, but was first seen by PCs during this draft.
 - Mordin Solus and others organize [a team](#) to make a cure for the virus. Both the proto-cure and the cure will not be completed until the second half, however.
 - To give the Cure Team space to work, two missions to retake the [hospital](#) and the [barracks](#) are launched on October 26th.
 - Optional Evacuation option given midday on October 28th, last through the end of the draft until 2:50 PM on October 31st.
- [Second half of the Draft](#) lasts from October 29th - October 31st
 - The Malnosso increase power-dampening in the enclosure to 100% midday on October 29th. Shortly after this, [Carol makes an announcement](#) urging everyone who is drafted and still in the enclosure to go home, as well as providing tips for those too brave or foolish to comply with that.
 - The [proto-cure](#) is completed and begins distribution on October 29th
 - The production of the cure is divided into two teams: one in the [Hospital](#) and one in the [MSF Lab](#). Both teams are working constantly during this period.
 - Beginning on October 29th as well, a team sets out to [find a rumored survivor](#), who turns out to be Korras Blake.
 - On the 30th, Obi-Wan Kenobi and Loki [find him](#). He is restrained by force and

taken in to the hospital, where his blood is a vital component in the cure.

- A cure is produced by the Luceti scientists, resulting in the bombing being called off. The Lucetians return on the 31st of October.

End Note from Charles

I considered putting together a guide in this same style for events before 2012/the onset of the mission system, but I feel in those cases the [Timeline](#) and [Plot](#) pages are usually fairly sufficient.

Not to mention the further back you go, the more muddled the information is, and because of that a play-by-play of events like this is less helpful than a straight guide, such as the [IC Guide](#) and the [OOC Nitpicker's Guide](#), both of which (and the updates in lucetilocked) are great resources.
