First of all, we asked a general question about how is Emir’s life going. He said that he tries his best to make his life grateful saying that “I am finding more and more reasons to be grateful.” He also mentioned about his country saying that “The political and social unrest in my countr can be quite unsettling at times.”

Right after that we asked three questions about Hasan’s son Sohrab such as his life, marriage, and his relationship with Emir. He gave relatively long answers however he mostly talked about what we already know. He said that “I am afraid I don’t have any definitive inforöation about Sohrab’s marital status or whether he has children of his own.” about the marriage question. Lastly, he said that “I am honored to walk alongside him as he continues to heal and grow.”

We asked two questions about his father. One of them was about the attitude of his father in the past. However, he gave very long explanation. Then we asked him to make it shorter. He said that “Now, I look back on that time with a deeper understanding and empathy.” The other question was about how did he feel towards his father when he learned that Hasan is his brother. Even though we wanted a brief explanation, he gave a long one. To make a long story short, he said that “I can’t help but feel a complex mix of emotions towards my father.”

We asked three questions about Hasan. One was about Hasan being Emir’s brother. The second one was about going to which moment he had with Hasan, If he had a chance. He said that there was a day which both of them were happy in Kabul. Then, we asked what he

Lastly, throughout the conversation Chatbot used some words implying facial expressions, body movements etc. such as “smiles warmly”, “not understandingly”, and “Emir pauses for a moment”.
