### Attendance

1. **Welcome Intro** – Robyn Lester, President of Booster Club. Will have meeting in January.
2. **Treasurer Report** – Melanie provided an update on the Booster account balance of \$43,097 in general account. Two fundraisers going on 1) Baseball at about \$3,500 2) Cheer at about \$1,000. All going well. No major upcoming bills.

Golf fundraiser raised about \$4k. 28-29 foursomes. Baseball/Mac's team won tournament. Trophy to be displayed in Baseball clubhouse. All positive feedback and Rene's phone was found 😊.

3. **Athletics Director Report** – AD Dunbar gave updates on Fall sports calendar and more:
  - Football Field not in good shape. AD contacting County to address it.
  - Field roller request for baseball field because football practices during baseball off season and correct it for the Spring. Roller will also be used for football field.
  - Baseball games PA repair (getting football stadium's old PA) and basketball PA wiring request – Quote will include install/fix wiring for baseball and basketball to include sponsorship in lieu of money.
  - Cheer competition – 12/16-17. Go fan set up. Friday night teams arrive 19 performances (17 different middle schools) and Saturday start at 9am – 4:30pm approx. 32 schools. JV from 9am-11, Varsity from noon-3pm. Co-hosting with Wakefield handling warm-up and Heritage handling gate and concessions/door monitoring. Will have 2 hospitality areas for coaches and judges. Need assistance with food, particularly on Friday night spectator food (pizza and sandwiches). Teams will bring coolers for team snacks. Volunteer email communications will be sent out. WFHS cheer team won the State Championship Non-Build. Jeris to make advertisement for cheer competition. This is a Wake County competition and should send out advertisement, but Booster Club will make post to get word out.
  - HSOT – WFHS has been asked to host again next year! Date tbd.
  - Sponsorships tbd.
  - Lease on lawnmower
  - Baseball field improvement to field and backstop.
  - Gym – Need to get gym spruced up, doors, banners, wall signs. AD getting prices to clean up area.
  - Softball Flagpole – Karen raised that Town field at Boys & Girls Club still needs a flagpole. AD will work w/Brittany to make sure Town is aware and make proposal of a donation from the School or the Booster Club for a flagpole.

4. **BoosterHub – boosterhub.com.** Robyn advised that we now have 646 members in the Hub. Still have 310 of 667 who have not taken next step in set up to receive communications and NEED TO DOWNLOAD APP.
