Grading Policy for Personal Finance:

40% Assessments: i.e. tests, quizzes, etc. This is primarily the students opportunity to show the knowledge of the subject and will be graded mostly for comprehension. - Mostly using scantron (multiple choice)

50% Assignments: This will primarily include in class activities that you were unable to complete. These are an opportunity for students to practice and will be graded primarily on effort, completion, following directions, and comprehension. I will do my best to keep grades up-to-date. Check your grades regularly! If you think there is an error, talk to me.

10% Participation: This will include **talking to your classmates**, practice exams, warm-ups, class activities, Kahoots, plus college and career readiness and will be graded similarly to assignments. Students will be learning Personal Finance as it relates to a variety of different fields and will be practicing good workplace behaviors: be respectful to self & others, be on time & prepared, put forth your best effort, stay on task, and maintain a good attitude.

Attendance: Regular attendance and being on time to class is mandatory to ensure educational success. Generally most students that don't come to class struggle and don't pass. Please let me know & check Google Classroom every class day!! Much of class work will be difficult to make-up due to the nature of the activity. This will be even more so this year than in past years. We will do a lot more group work this year. Students are responsible for obtaining and completing missing work/quizzes/tests/in class activities/etc in a timely manner. If you cut class or have an unexcused absence you will not be able to make-up missed work. You will receive a zero. This includes exams.

Excused absences will receive full credit for work. You will have the amount of time absent (for excused absences ONLY) to turn in work for full credit. I.e. out for two days, on the third day of your return, you must turn-in/show missing work. It is your job to make-up missed work in a timely manner or you will receive a zero. This includes exams. My goal is to keep google classroom and grades up-to-date. **Use them!**

Homework: Homework will generally be any unfinished class work. I don't assign much homework for this class. If you are in class & on task you will have little to no homework in this class. However this is a math class for credit plus we all work and learn at different paces so some of you will have work to do outside of class. Take pride in your work! Please use full sentences (mostly), proofread & "highlight" your work, and give thoughtful and complete answers (especially that done in google classroom).

My goal is to give you ample class time to work, use it wisely. If you miss class, please be prepared to spend that time working outside of class. Remember to take breaks, follow the 20/20/20 rule and please don't spend too much time in front of/on electronics. Please go outside every day!

<u>Cheating/plagiarizing will not be tolerated</u>. Any student caught cheating/plagiarizing will receive an Zero on the assignment for the first offense. The second offense will result in an "F" grade for the entire grading period. Your work needs to be your own; however, I encourage you to work with and discuss your ideas with others in and outside of class.

<u>Late/missing work:</u> Please turn your work in on time! In the past I did not accept late work. I hope to not have to implement it this year. <u>Late work will not receive full credit</u> (usually 30% off), unless it is an excused absence or an accommodation. Late work can add a lot of extra work to the teacher. This class is more fun if we are working on the same topic/assignment. However, the most important aspect of this class is that you are learning; thus <u>generally I take work most late assignments for partial credit for the term only</u>. I WILL NOT BE TAKING LATE WORK AFTER THE END OF EACH GRADING PERIOD (9/29, 11/3,

12/21, 3/1, 4/26, **6/13**.. **Note I can not take late work after the end of the semester**, since I have grades due. I do not offer incompetes. Please plan accordingly. Thank you.

<u>Tarties</u>: Please come to class on time!! Coming to class, coming on time & being ready to learn is the best path for success. If you are not in your assignment seat when the bell rings, you are tardy & will be marked tardy. If you are perpetually late to class, there will be consequences and your learning will be impacted.
