Airline Baggage Info:

Carry-on Bag: One bag, maximum dimensions of 22 x 14 x 9 inches (56 x 35 x 23 cm).

- Shoes for walking/working (tennis shoes recommended) also sandals are good for around the mission house
- Light rain jacket
- Church Attire:
 - Men: Pants/shorts & golf shirt (business casual with tennis shoes or sandals)
 - Women: Sundress or nice shorts/shirt

Health & Weather

• **Tetanus shot:** Highly recommended (ensure it's up to date but not required)

• **Temperatures:** (land of eternal spring)Upper 70s during the day, 60s at night -prepare for some rain
