


The Times World Higher Education Impact Ranking system uses calibrated SDG indicators to assess Universities across three broad areas Research, Outreach and Stewardship. The objective of the session was 1) To develop better understanding about the concept of SDG; 2) To understand the relevance of SDG; 3) Reflect on application of SDG in CU


