  - Jules: open call for questions / new business

    - Why is CANSPEI not including New Brunswick and Newfoundland? Curious about potential expansion in the future.
  - Jules:
    - CCA exists as a national body. Each province has a “PCA” or provincial camping association. Looking at the East Coast, CANSPEI was previously CANS and PEI eventually joined when their own camping association was no longer functioning effectively. Board has previously had conversations about expansion, as NB and NFLD do not currently have functioning camping associations. Jules estimates that is in the 5-7 year timeline.
  - Matt:
    - NB currently has representative at CCA. Newfoundland does not currently. Uncertainty about voting representation on CCA body - currently, NS/PEI only have one vote as two provinces. Concern that would eliminate other Atlantic votes if all combined.
    - Additional goal to expand government representation from PEI in CANSPEI.
