

Enrolling and Continuing in York Institute Clinics

The York Institute offers an array of wellness, rehabilitative, and related educational services to children and adults with varying abilities and needs who are underserved or require supplemental or specialty services. These services are part of Nazareth University's clinical education programs that prepare undergraduate and graduate students for licensure/certification and careers in education, health, and human services. Services are provided on a space-available basis to meet students' clinical requirements as determined by clinic managers.

A number of factors are considered in the determination of clinic enrollment:

- Providing clinical cases that meet students' scope of practice needs and level of preparation
- Prior attendance/participation record
- Your schedule availability
- Availability of supervision
- Availability of student clinicians
- Demand for services/waitlists

Selection for participation in a York Institute clinic is at the sole discretion of the clinic manager. York Institute clinics operate in a variety of formats and schedules, and the numbers of student clinicians in each clinic varies each semester. You/your child may be eligible for services in one clinic and not be eligible in another during the same semester.
