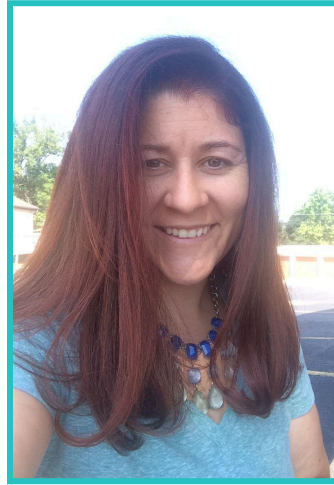

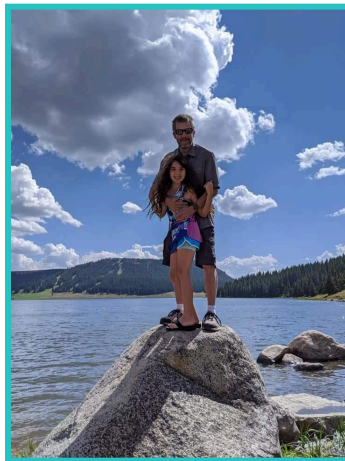


Kelly Lynn Cronin

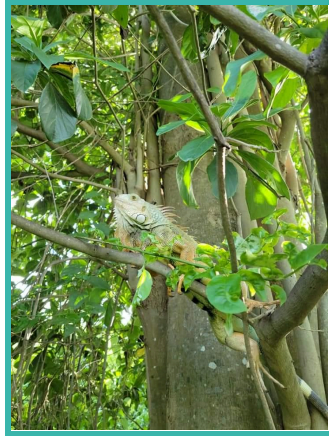
I realized that while I was busy going places, I was too busy to be places.

Solar Power

Two small solar panels power much of the house including the fans and some of the lights and one-half of many of the outlets. If your devices are charging slowly please move them to the other side of the outlet for more juice. This exists to not only save on electricity but also to ensure that regardless of power outages on the island, guests have access to sustainable power.

Heat/Air conditioning

You will find the remote control for the mini-split unit in the desk drawer below the unit. Please do not set the AC below 68 to avoid burning out the unit. 70-75 is comfortable. Electric on the island is precious and the unit is fast to freeze you, so please turn off the unit when not in the house. Use the mode “cool” for AC. Leave the fan setting on “high” to get the best cool. “LED” turns the light off on the unit to ensure a dark sleep experience.

Shades on the French Doors

These bad boys go up by lifting the bar on the bottom. Crazy, right?

Cook top

The power button is all the way on the right.

Once turned on if it is locked for safety, push and hold the lock button next to the power button.

Smaller pans do not work as well on the induction stove tops. If you are getting variable heat, please switch to a larger pan.
