

Site Administration Zone Jurisdiction Policy Site-65

This policy dictates zone boundaries and who has authority over Site personnel. This is protected and enforced by the Foundation Legal Codex.





Mobile Task Force 'Hammer Down' Nu-7

MTF Nu-7 has complete authority to ID check and detain anyone in Entrance Zone, Floor 2, Lobby and the Garage area when applicable (Code-1, 914 being used without authorization, mass D-Class escape...). Failure to produce ID is a violation of the following Foundation Legal Codex articles:

- Insubordination Count 2
- Trespass Count 2

MTF Nu-7 also has authority over the requisition of vehicles from the garage. Any MTF Commissioned Officer from any regiment may requisition vehicles without the express permission of MTF Nu-7. Failure to abide by this will be direct violation of the following Foundation Legal Codex articles:

- Public Nuisance Count 1
- Protocol Count 1
- Misuse Count 2

MTF Nu-7 must contact Internal Affairs to collect staff who violate these policies.





Mobile Task Force Epsilon-11 'Nine Tailed Fox'

MTF E-11 has complete authority over the Heavy Containment Zone and Light Containment Zone - SCPs side. MTF E-11 have the authority to ID check and detain anybody inside the Containment Zones at any time. Failure to abide by their request will be a violation of the following Foundation Legal Codex articles:

- Insubordination Count 2
- Trespass Count 2

MTF E-11 have the authority to deny all personnel from entering the Containment Zones, except Security Containment Units, until their Non-Commissioned Officer's or higher authorise it. Site Command and Site Administration can override this policy if they deem it necessary. However, all efforts to be made to ensure MTF E-11 have full control over breaches within the Containment Zone areas. Failure to abide by MTF E-11's orders in the Containment Zone is chargeable by the following Foundation Legal Codex articles:

- Trespass Count 2
- Protocol Count 1
- Public Nuisance Count 1

MTF E-11 CO's also hold the authority to lockdown a sector in both Containment Zones with sufficient reasoning and Site Administration approval, unless Site

Administration are unavailable. It may be locked down for an hour maximum.

Misuse of this policy will revert back to the authority being granted explicitly by Site Administration.

General Security Department - Site 65

GENSEC has complete authority over the operations in the D-block area. GENSEC has full authority to ID check and detain anyone, and challenge their presence there. GENSEC Security Response and Patrol Units may also ID Check anyone in Lower Containment Zone when applicable (Code-1, 914 being used without authorization, mass D-Class escape...). If asked to leave D-Block by GENSEC Security Response Unit and/or GENSEC Officer and you do not comply, you violate the following Foundation Legal Codex articles:

- Trespass Count 2
- Public Nuisance Count 1

GENSEC are permitted to expel any non-combative staff of a Clearance Level 3 or lower from D-Block to ensure their safety when a Code 2 - Riot In Progress is called or a Code 1 - Intruder Alert is effecting D-Block. Failure to abide by this violates the following Foundation Legal Codex articles:





- Insubordination Count 2

GENSEC can expel anyone who is not a Combat Medic or an Nu-7 Operative, from the D-Block Watchtower and Catwalk. Failure to abide by this violates the following Foundation Legal Codex articles:

- Insubordination Count 2
- Public Nuisance Count 1

GENSEC Security Containment Units have full access to all areas within the Lower Containment Zone and have access to Heavy Containment Zone to properly conduct their primary duties and patrol routes as containment units. They have an extension of power from E-11's authority within the Lower Containment Zone.


They do not hold authority to remove people from the Heavy Containment Zone, but have the same access as E-11 within.

<u>Medical Department - Site 65</u>

If you are not a member of the medical team on Site, you are not to enter beyond the double doors past the waiting area into the rest of the medical bay area without valid reasoning and permission from Medical Personnel. Site Administration and Site Command may enter freely. If medical personnel request you to leave the medical bay

area, you must abide by their demand. Failure to abide by this violates the following Foundation Legal Codex articles:

- Insubordination Count 2
- Public Nuisance Count 1
- Trespass Count 2

Internal Affairs have the right to enter and arrest violators of this policy.

Internal Affairs - Site 65

The Internal Affairs Department can request anyone to leave the Interrogation area. Site Administration and Site Command are exempt from this request. Agents and Operatives may also assist in any ID checks, site wide (except for Garage and HCZ). Agents and Operatives hold authority inside of Interrogation in regards to what happens with arrested Foundation personnel. Failure to abide by this policy violates the following Foundation Legal Codex articles:

- Trespass Count 2
- Insubordination Count 2





External Affairs - Site 65

The External Affairs Department cannot be requested to leave interrogation if there is a GOI member and/or intruder inside. Likewise, they can ask anyone to leave under that same circumstance.

Site Administration, Site Command (ISD If present with Site Command) and Nu-7 CO+ are exempt from this request. Failure to abide by this policy violates the following Foundation Legal Codex articles:



The Department of External Affairs has permission to ID check anyone within the site when applicable (Code-1, 914 being used without authorization, mass D-Class escape...). Failure to show ID is a violation of the following Foundation Legal Codex articles:

- Insubordination Count 2
- Trespass Count 2

External Affairs Clearance Level Four personnel have authority to authorise the use of vehicles for their department, along with NU-7.







This policy is enforced by their respective departments. Internal Affairs and ISD are exempt from being barred entry to these areas if they need to carry out their respective duties and they identify themselves as Internal Affairs/ISD. This policy is enforced by Site Administration of Site-65.
