

Year 2 Planner – Giants and Dreams

Topic (Geography and History)

The children will take a journey with the BFG around a map of the United Kingdom collecting dreams and learning about famous British landmarks as they go. We will learn about significant famous people from the past through learning about the author, Roald Dahl and illustrator Quentin Blake. We will also enjoy creating Dream jars and making dream catchers.

English

As we move on to our new topic, our focus will be around the sequencing, adapting and rewriting the traditional tale of Jack and the Beanstalk. We will also read The BFG by Roald Dahl and will be exploring characters, settings and story plots as we make our way through the topic. We will also be making SPaG (Spelling, Punctuation and Grammar) a key focus of this term. In Read Write Inc we will continue to focus on the different sounds and apply our understanding to both reading and writing. In Guided Reading, the children will continue to use the VIPERS skills to read and understand extracts from The Land of Roar.

Czech

V tomto termu nás nadále čeká čtení a psaní písmem Comenia script a rozvoj pasivního porozumění českému psacímu písmu. Cvičit budeme rovněž jeho přepis do písma Comenia script. Poprvé v tomto termu nahlédneme do tajů čtenářského deníku a společně si vytvoříme první zápisek. V prvouce se kromě jarních tradic budeme věnovat zvířatům domácím i volně žijícím a zaměříme se na praktické zkoumání vlastností látek. V matematice se nově seznámíme např. se základy násobení a vytrváme při důkladném procvičování rozkladu čísel. Seznámíme se s vlastnostmi těles (3D tvarů).

Mathematics

In Mathematics this term, we will explore, name and identify the properties of 2D and 3D shapes. We will also think about lines of symmetry and shape patterns. We will also cover money, with a focus on counting, comparing, calculating and problem solving. We will then move on to multiplication and division, using concrete and pictorial representations in order to demonstrate our understanding.

Science

Our Science this term will be all about plants; we will observe how seeds and bulbs grow into mature plants, and find out and describe how plants need water, light and a suitable temperature to grow and stay healthy.

Physical Education

Students will participate in a variety of fun physical activities. These activities will focus on developing coordination, agility, balance and strength. They will also include activities such as agility ladders, exercise to music, animal movements and equipment control games. The pupils will be also on hockey and wall skills.

Computing

This term we will be diving into programming and exploring how a set of instructions can create an algorithm. The pupils will use BeeBots and RootRobots to create a set of instructions to achieve a goal, test and debug their designs. Additionally, we will spend some time getting to know Microsoft Word.

Music

The topic for this half term is

Art

The children will study Salvador Dalí and recreate their own dream paintings. Dream painting techniques. They will also use watercolours to study and recreate their own Quentin Blake giant characters.

PSHE (Personal, Social, Health and Economic Education)

Children will continue to develop an understanding of how one's own behaviour affects other people. We will learn to listen to other people's point of view and how to respectfully agree and disagree with others.
