

## Colorization

### *Select and Color*

Find a photo of a zebra using a Google image search:

1. Launch Adobe PhotoShop
2. Open the picture
3. Image>Mode>RGB
4. Use one of the selection tools to make a selection of one of the zebra stripes
5. Image>Adjustments>Hue/Saturation
6. Checkmark Colorize in the bottom right
7. Slide the Hue, Saturation, and Lightness arrows to mix a color you like
8. Click OK
9. Select>Deselect
10. Using one of the selection tools, make another selection of one of the zebra stripes
11. Repeat steps 6-10 with another stripe of the zebra
