

Silicon Valley Entrepreneur Incubation Program of Taiwan Tech Affidavit

I, _____ (hereinafter referred to as Party B), a member of _____ (team name), agree to apply for the Silicon Valley Entrepreneur Incubation Program of Taiwan Tech (hereinafter referred to as the Program) organized by the National Taiwan University of Science and Technology (hereinafter referred to as Party A). I undertake to submit all relevant documents and fully participate in the implementation of the Program in accordance with the relevant provisions of the Program after receiving the subsidy approval notice. Party B has clearly understood the following statement and agrees to the provisions listed by Party A. This Affidavit is hereby issued as evidence.

I. The agreed items regarding the Program are as follows:

- (I) Party B guarantees that it fully understands the means of implementation and announcement of the Program and agrees to abide by all regulations.
- (II) Party B fully understands that it may not submit an application if any of the startup teams it once belonged to has received subsidy from the Program within two years prior to the submission of the current application.
- (III) Party B agrees that after receiving the Program subsidy, it shall complete the Program no later than November 30 of the current year from the date of the announcement of the review results.
- (IV) In accordance with the above, if Party B fails to complete the Program by November 30 of the current year, it shall be deemed to have automatically forfeited the opportunity and no objection shall be raised.
- (V) Party B agrees to abide by all provisions of the Program after receiving the Program subsidy:
 1. Participation in a series of entrepreneurship-related activities organized by the Silicon Valley Center and the Business Incubation Center of Party A: Visits to companies and related institutions as well as exchange meetings with the Taiwan Tech Alumni Association of Northern California during the trip to Silicon Valley (the team must collect feedback forms from the visited entities; the forms shall be submitted to the Business Incubation Center of Party A after the activities have ended and shall serve as a reference for the evaluation of the training progress). In addition, the team must attend the Silicon Valley Program Experience Sharing Session after returning to Taiwan.
 2. Submission of relevant reports: Teams that have completed the Program in the United States must submit the Silicon Valley Entrepreneur Incubation Program of Taiwan Tech Overseas Progress Report within 14 working days after returning to Taiwan. The Report must be submitted as a Word document. For the content and format of the Report, please refer to Appendix 7. In addition, post-training reflections in the form of a video (within three minutes) and image files of the sites visited shall be provided. Lastly, teams are required to give an oral presentation at the Business Incubation Center.
 3. Party B agrees that the organizer has the right to assemble and publish the above application documents, as well as any sounds, pictures, texts, images, physical designs, or creative ideas related to the application in any location without restriction.
 4. Follow-ups on training effectiveness: Party B shall cooperate with the Program's executors with regards to following up on the effectiveness of the

Program and provide all related information regarding the results of the company/team's operations. Party B shall also cooperate with the Program on following up on the effectiveness of talent training and provide information on team development along with the career paths of team members.

5. Participation in related promotional events after returning to Taiwan: Party B shall assist the organizer in the presentation of the results of the Program along with any related work at promotional events held by the organizer.
 6. Joining the Business Incubation Center: If the team of Party B establishes a company in the future, the company must join the Taiwan Tech Business Incubation Center.
 7. Students shall handle all issues with regards to enrollment by themselves.
 8. Violations of the obligations of this Program shall lead to the automatic termination of the subsidy.
- (VI) Party B certifies the originality of its competing work (and the ideas/technologies used) and that it has not plagiarized the work of others.
- (VII) Party B certifies that the competing work (and the ideas/technologies used) is its intellectual property and that it does not violate the intellectual property rights of others.
- (VIII) Party B shall be held civilly liable for collateral damages and shall return the provided subsidy if any misrepresentation, failure to carry out the contents of the proposed Program, or the termination of the Program should happen.

If Party B violates any of the above items, Party B's guarantor and Party B shall bear all liabilities and shall hold all others and Taiwan Tech harmless.
