

Fort Worth ISD E-Cigarette (Vape) Policy 2026-2027 Student/Parent Acknowledgement

Policy Overview

The possession, use, sale, or distribution of e-cigarettes (vapes) is prohibited on school property and at school-related events in accordance with the Fort Worth ISD Student Code of Conduct and Texas Education Code Chapter 37.

Definition

E-cigarettes (vapes) include any electronic device or component used to deliver nicotine, THC, or any other substance through vapor or aerosol.

Student Expectations

Students shall not:

- Possess or use e-cigarettes or vaping devices
- Sell, give, or deliver e-cigarettes or vaping devices to another individual.

Students are responsible for the contents of their personal belongings at all times.

Policy Clarifications

Possession

A student is considered in possession of a prohibited item if it is found on their person, in their belongings, or under their control, regardless of ownership.

Disciplinary Determinations

Disciplinary decision will be determined in accordance with the Student Code of Conduct, Texas Education Code of Chapter 37, and district policy.

Students Receiving Special Education or Section 504 Services

Disciplinary decision will comply with all applicable federal and state laws, including IDEA and Section 504, as well as district policy.

Healthy and Safety Awareness

I understand that vaping is not safe and may negatively impact health.
