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Non-Negotiables:

- All K-8 teachers should be working a full school day; changes to schedule w/o admin approval will result in disciplinary action
- Using Second STEP as a SEL Curriculum for Morning Meetings
- Morning Meetings are to be no less than 30 minutes
- Attendance must be logged in by 9:30 am each day
- What I Need Period in the form of blended learning (Zearn & Lexia)
- All MTSS Academics Plans must be updated on the B week
- All MTSS Attendance/Behavior Plans must be updated on the A Week
- Lesson Plans/Weeks at a Glance are handed in on Sundays in your assigned Google Classroom
- Coop Logs are completed at the end of each class and Dojo Points up are given out during each class period
- PLC Binders and Quick Cards should be brought to PLC and protocols should be read prior to weekly meetings
- All classroom must use the Hall Pass Log Book and the color coded Hall Passes
- Anchor Charts must be used to anchor your DLT. Charts must be created with your students
- Responding to parents around attendance, classroom behaviors, new admissions, ADWs etc.... Must be done within 24-48 hours of the incident.
- Performance and Movement tracker must be updated at least 3 days from the last assessment day
- Data Talks with students must take place every quarter during the 3 report card half days.
- All Classroom Community Expectations built with students MUST be posted
- Calming Corners must not be used as a disciplinary consequence or punishment. It is not a time out!

Students move from using the blocks to drawing the blocks to writing the number two ways. Notice that two of the three strategies can be used during any standardized test with scrap paper.
