



2026 Priscilla Chan STRIDE Service Program Postgraduate Fellowship

Fellowship Description

The Priscilla Chan STRIDE Service Program Postgraduate Fellowships, formerly known as STRIDE Rite, are intended for Harvard college seniors or college seniors who are alumni participants of PBHA programs who were devoted to service as undergraduates, and who demonstrate a commitment to a lifetime of future service to and with community. The spirit of the award is to provide fellows with the opportunity to put their vision for social change into action. Each fellow is awarded *up to* \$40,000. The grant money is intended to support the fellow's living expenses as they work on a public interest project full-time in the year following graduation. The money may not be used for project expenses, but fellows are encouraged to seek other project funding, if applicable.

The committee generally favors projects with the following characteristics:

- Entrepreneurial
- Community based
- Within the U.S. (ideally in a community with which the applicant has worked in the past)
- Builds on undergraduate service experience
- Potential for ongoing impact

The committee generally favors applicants with the following characteristics:

- Participated in year-round public service during their undergraduate career
- Built long-term relationships with one or more communities
- Plan to work in a human services profession long-term
- Passionate, energetic, effective leaders

Wednesday, March 25, 2026 at 5:00 PM**

The selection committee reviews applications immediately and will notify the finalists to appear for interviews in early April. Finalists will be required to come in for interviews. Grants of *up to* \$40,000 will be awarded (budget and program plans are considered in the specific award amount).

Awardees will be notified in April 2026 after interviews. If selected, you will be invited to receive your award at an end-of-year awards reception at PBHA's Public Service Celebration in Quincy Dining Hall, with a Senior Reception on the Quincy rooftop immediately preceding dinner. Date and time TBD.

Proposal	A summary of your proposed project and the impact that you hope to make (800 words)	
Résumé	Your current résumé.	
Unofficial or Official Harvard transcript	Your transcript can be obtained from the Registrar’s Office, 20 Garden Street or through your student records online. Please make sure the file is not encrypted/protected upon submission.

All Chan Stride Post-graduate fellows must work with a host or sponsoring organization. The organization should be mission aligned. Sponsoring organizations may provide a range of supports. Minimum requirements for sponsorship include: providing supervision and guidance for the post-graduate fellow and helping the fellow to secure a location for their project.

Applicants must submit a letter of sponsorship from the partner organization. The letter should detail the organization's commitment to and capacity for supporting the proposed project. Additionally, the letter should describe how the proposed project meets an existing unmet community need. Letters should be on organizational letterhead.

Please note- fellowships will not be provided to cover staffing of existing positions. Projects should be mission aligned to the sponsoring organization and should extend organizational capacity/ meet an unmet need.
