

WAVE75 QMK Upgrade Instructions

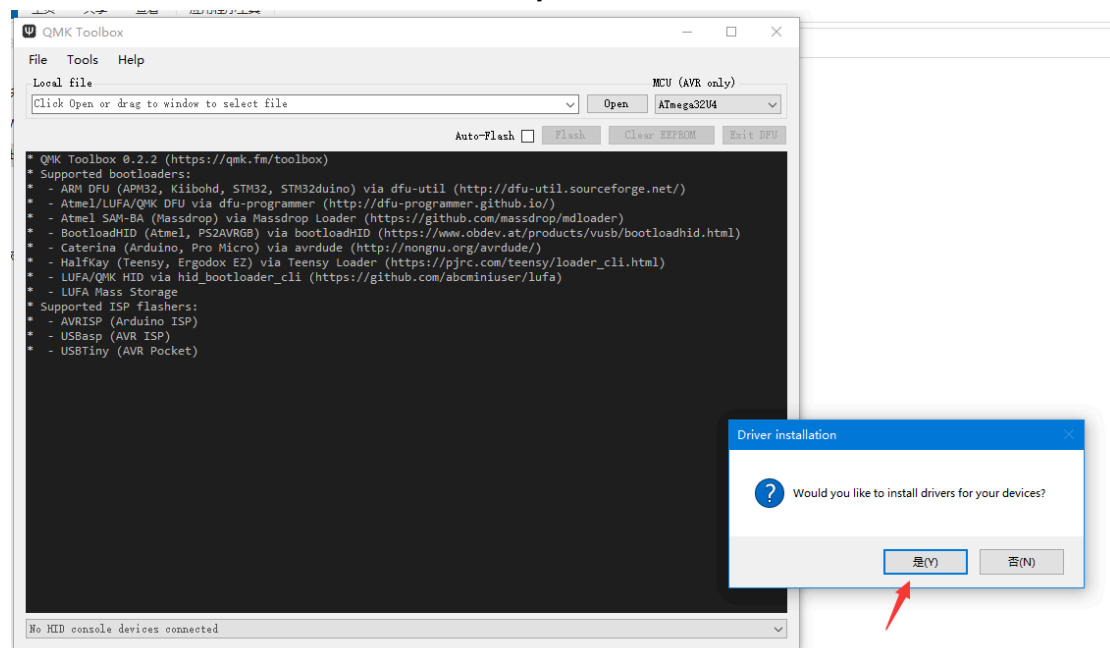
1. Unplug the keyboard data cable – do not plug it in (the keyboard battery switch should be in the OFF position).
2. Right-click the firmware BIN file, select Properties, then Read-only, and uncheck the box (this example uses the RGB version BIN



file).

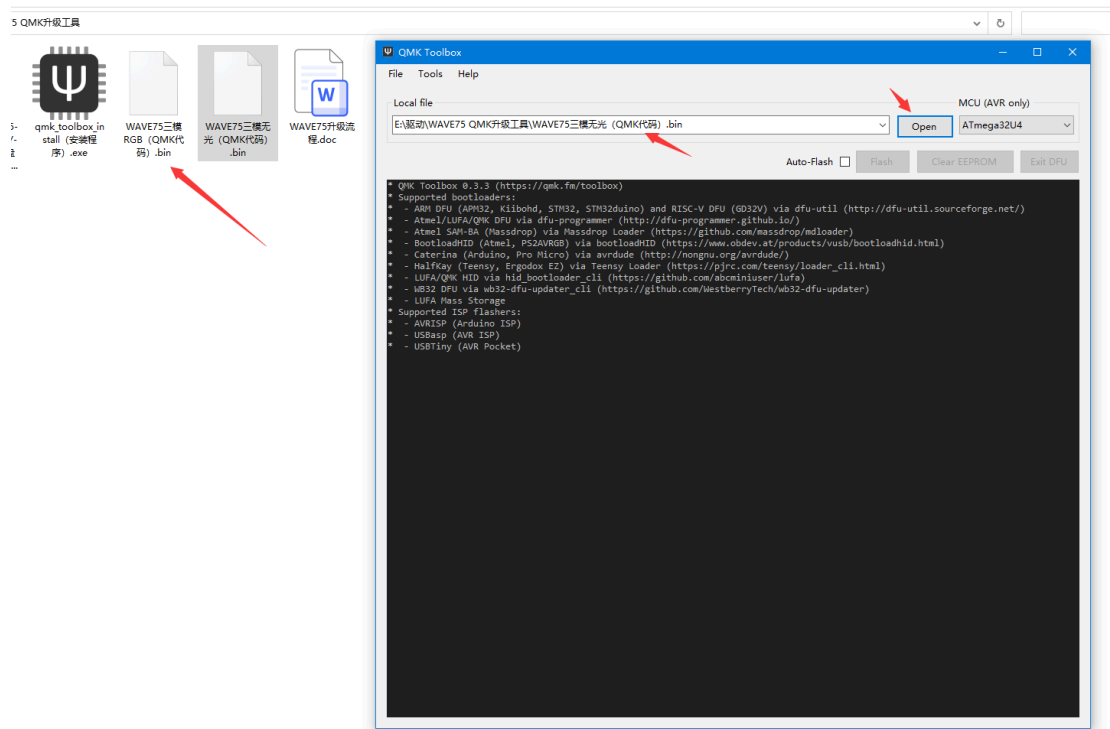
3. After opening the QMK upgrade tool and installing the software, find the desktop shortcut to open it (some computers may

require a software update after opening - as shown in the picture - click Yes - it will be done in a few seconds).



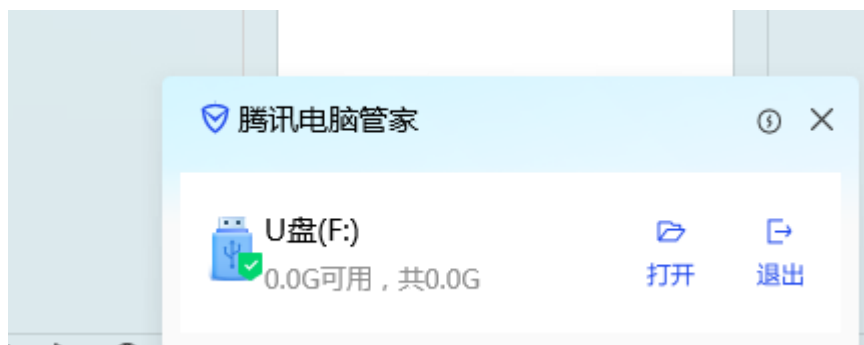
4. Then, in the window, select the "Open" option tool and choose the "WAVE75 bin" code file.

(Note: For the RGB version, select the RGB code file; for the non-RGB version, select the non-RGB code file.)

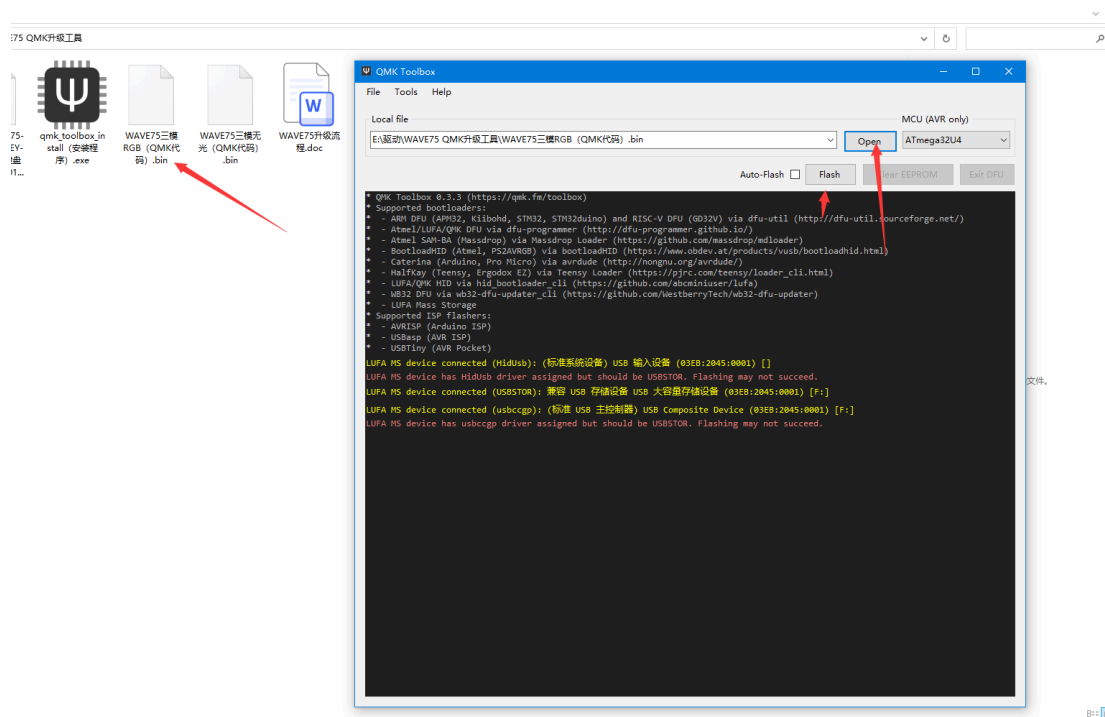


5. Press and hold the ESC key while inserting the keyboard data cable. Release the ESC key when a USB flash drive prompt window appears in the lower right corner of the computer.

Note: The upgrade must be performed in wired mode, and the battery power must be turned off.



6. Click the installation interface --- the Flash button --- wait about 10 seconds.



7. After installation, the keyboard backlight will turn on. Close the window below.

(Note: If the wrong BIN file is selected, the keyboard backlight file will not match after installation. Ensure the version matches the correct BIN file. If an error occurs, please disconnect the cable and re-import.)
