Absaroka-Beartooth Outfitters Lodge, Cabins & Cottage

Absaroka-Beartooth Outfitters Lodge, Cabins and Western Cottage are located on Cross Triangle Ranch, a working cattle and sheep ranch, in Big Timber, Montana. We offer comfortable and affordable lodging from which to base your explorations in Big Sky Country. Lodge, cabin and cottage guests have a variety of fun activities to fill their days. We are happy to accommodate special events upon request.

Activity options include float trips and fishing on the Yellowstone River. A popular option is horseback riding on our working cattle and sheep ranch. If you want to help feed the sheep or salt and mineral a few cows, we can always use an extra hand. However, the extra hand is not always available due to the changing ranch schedule. Helicopter rides to access a day in the mountains are also available. You choose, we provide the experience. Families welcomed!

Absaroka-Beartooth Outfitters Lodge – provides comfortable rooms with vistas of the Crazy Mountains, green grasslands for horse and cattle grazing and a pond. There are five rooms in the lodge. Two of the rooms have a queen bed & an extra-long twin bed in each room, two rooms have two extra-long twin beds in each room and one room has one queen bed. The rooms share two full baths with another full bath in the main lodge. There is a washer and dryer conveniently located near the rooms for guests. A microwave and refrigerator are available for guest use in the main lodge. The main lodge is a large open concept room with a sitting and TV area, dining area and kitchen. The main lodge kitchen is not available for guests to cook but a cook is available upon request for an extra charge.

Lodge Room Cost: \$120 per room/per night for three or more nights.
\$130 per room per night for one or two nights.

The rooms accommodate two people per room (some rooms will sleep 3 people). There is an additional charge of \$20 per night for a 3rd person. Check in time is 4:00 pm. Check out time is 10:00 am.



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Cabins - ABO offers guests looking for a rustic cabin experience two dry cabins, meaning no running water and no bathrooms in the cabins. Each cabin sleeps up to 4 people. Both cabins have full size refrigerators with tables and chairs for eating. One cabin has a queen bed and a twin bed on the main floor and another twin bed in the loft. The other cabin has two twin beds on the main floor and a queen bed in the loft. There are bathrooms in the ABO Lodge for cabin guests that are only a short distance from the cabins.

Cabin Cost: \$140 per cabin/per night for three nights or more.
\$150 per cabin/per night for one or two nights. Each cabin accommodates 4 people.
Check in time is 4:00 pm. Check out time is 10:00 am.

The Cottage - Another lodging option ABO offers, is a 900 sq. ft. cottage near the lodge. It has 2 bedrooms, a well equipped kitchen with open concept living and dining areas, a full bath, and a patio with a fire pit. A washer & dryer are available for guest use and located at the ABO Lodge. The cottage is comfortably furnished, sleeps up to 5 people with extra long twin beds in one bedroom and a queen size bed in the other bedroom. An additional twin bed can be added for a 5th person. This cozy but roomy cottage is private but conveniently located near the Absaroka-Beartooth Lodge and has a spectacular view of the Crazy Mountains.

Cottage Cost: \$300 per night – minimum 2 nights
Weekly rental - \$1650 - Friday -Thursday (7 days, 6 nights)
Check in time is 4:00 pm Check out time is 10:00 am

Meals: Meals are available upon request, please contact the ranch for details.

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Activities

2-Hour Horseback Rides – \$150 per person/minimum 2 people

BYOL Rides (bring your own lunch) - \$180 (adds approximately 30-45 minutes to ride)
Custom rides available

Riding lessons available upon request
Horse rides available year-round, weather permitting

Float trips on the Yellowstone – \$150 per person/minimum 2 people 2-hour trips
(available to lodge and cottage guests only)

Saddle & Paddle - \$280 per person/minimum 2 people - Includes 2 hour morning ride & two hour early afternoon float trip, providing time for lunch on your own in Big Timber between ride and raft.

Walk & Wade Fishing – guided
One or Two Anglers: \$650 - half day trips (approximately 4 hours)

Helicopter Trips – This trip is for the person that wants a day trip to the mountains. ABO works with a helicopter service that will pick you up at the Bozeman airport and fly you to our drop zone in the backcountry. We will be there to meet you as you step out of the Heli and show you some country from horseback or ATV few get to experience.

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Deposit & Refund Policy for Lodge, Cabins & Cottage

Reservations are required to guarantee your room. A 50% deposit is required to confirm your reservation. The balance of your reservation is due 30 days prior to arrival.

We accept Credit Cards, ACH and Checks. We invoice clients through Quickbooks.

100% refund if reservation is canceled at least 30 days prior to check-in.

50% refund if reservation is canceled two weeks (14 days) prior to check-in.

0% refund if reservation is canceled less than 14 days prior to check-in.

Deposit Policy for Horseback Riding, Saddle & Paddle, and Float Trips

Reservations are required to book ABO activities. To book a reservation we require a 25% deposit. Your deposit is non refundable. The balance of your payment is due upon arrival for your activity. **Payments can be made either through Venmo or with a credit card.**

Deposit Policy for Walk & Wade Fishing, Float Fishing and Helicopter Trips

Reservations are required to book ABO trips. To book a reservation we require a 50% deposit. Your deposit is non-refundable. The balance of your payment is due 30 days prior to your trip date and is non-refundable. We recommend Trip Cancellation Insurance. Montana Outfitters & Guides Association suggests Global Rescue travel insurance.

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From Bozeman take Interstate 90 to Big Timber. Take the 1st Big Timber Exit and go left under I 90 to the light. *

From Billings take I 90 to Big Timber. Take the 2nd Big Timber Exit and go right to the light. *

***At the light turn left on the frontage road.** You will be heading west. Go approximately one mile. Turn right at the first place you can cross the railroad tracks. Cross the railroad tracks and follow the ranch road to the brown barn.
