TPMGA RED – WHITE – BLUE 2023 EVENT RULES

Red - White - Blue Scramble (Date: Saturday, July 1st)

Definition: This event is like a scramble where all players hit off from the same tee and then they decide which ball is in the best position. Each player then drops their ball within a club length of the selected ball, no nearer the hole. They hit their next stroke from this position. They then make a similar selection after the next shot and play continues in this way until the hole is finished.

Team Selection / Tee Times: The signup sheet will expire on. The teams will be randomly drawn by flight based on their handicap index as of June 28, 2023.

All players on each team will play the same six (6) holes from the red tees, the same six (6) holes from the white, and the same six (6) holes from the blue tees randomly chosen and checked with the appropriate tee box on the score card (See Example Below). You do not have to preselect the holes prior to the tournament and can select as you play prior to teeing off on that hole. Once a tee box is selected for a hole all four players must play from that tee box. If you do not have six (6) holes from the red tees, six (6) holes from the white, and six (6) holes from the blue tees choose and checked (X) with the appropriate tee box on the scorecard, you will be disqualified. There are no minimum drives required.

If the selected ball is in the rough or a hazard, the other balls must be dropped in the rough or hazard. On the putting surface, all balls must be placed and putted from within a putter head of the spot where the selected ball lies, no closer to the hole.

The Red – White – Blue Event is scored as a stroke event where one gross score is shown on the card. Score Cards must be signed by Scorer prior to posting.

In the event of a tie score for First Place Only, the teams will have a chip-off. A minimum of two players must be present for the chip-off to qualify, otherwise, they forfeit. Each team will choose two players. The two players chosen from each team will add their combined total distance from the circumference edge of the cup. Note: all chips must stay on the green, if off the green the distance cannot be counted. In the event, all the players from the same team miss the green and one player from the opposite team stays on the green the team with the player on the green will be the winner. Likewise, in the event, one player from the same team stays on the green and two players from the opposite team stay on the green the team with the two players on the green will be the winner.

In the event there is a tie or are ties for other places, they will be broken starting with the most difficult handicap hole (Handicap 1 - hole #3) backward, Handicap 2 hole #18, Handicap 3, etc. (TPMGA Score Card will be used)
