

8th Grade Supply List

Homeroom and general middle school supplies

- headphones
- refillable water bottle - please bring to school daily to eliminate the wasteful use of cups
- black/blue ink pens
- pencils
- 2 packs of loose-leaf lined paper
- a pack of colored pencils
- 2 boxes of tissues
- 1 roll of paper towels
- either a bottle of hand sanitizer or a pack of clorox wipes
- hanging locker book organizer (not required, but some students find them helpful)

ELA

- one 1-inch binder

Social Studies & Spanish

- One 2-inch binder (to be shared by Social Studies and Spanish)
- Dividers

- Spiral bound notebook
- TI-30XII scientific calculator

Algebra I

- 4 AAA batteries for the graphing calculator (school provides the graphing calculator)
- notebook - nothing major and you can even use the back of your science notebook

Science

- notebook - not a huge expensive one, can be part of a multisubject notebook
- folder - if your notebook has a folder, you don't necessarily need an extra one

Religion

- single subject spiral notebook
