

General costs

I have to ask to exclude these costs from the possible refund if the project doesn't get finished in time with the schedule:

Costs:

- a. [heroku hosting](#) 50\$/month (x12),
- b. [Google playstore dev account](#) 25\$
- c. [Apple store dev fee](#) 99\$/year
- d. [Construct 3 fee](#) 123.69\$/year
- e. varda.vision domain registration (to renew on 2nd sept) € 26,49 + VAT

Services

1. Creation and pose to work online and for mobile devices of an HTML5 click to play/play to earn game based on NFT ownership on the NEAR blockchain for a 1 year duration. Timing 3 months from the 15th of January 2022.
2. Creation and pose to work of an online NFT marketplace with User Generated Content to be used to grow investment attitude in the near NFT ecosystem in collaboration with Metapool (details of collaboration are being negotiated, we will have exclusive access to the staking contract from the Varda Vault contract). Timing 2 months from the Play to earn game launch.

What we ask for the second service point is only the cost of building the platform according to [this template code here](#), we'll take responsibility on any line of code we change/add to those templates. Given the above costs are met this second service point would involve discord and social channels management, usually a single pro discord community manager [costs 20K/year part time](#) without the social media part, we wish to continue our partnership in a growing way in order to be able to pay the community manager by ourselves or asking some other funds to the guild.

Schedule and Payments

We would like to divide the payment for the agreement in 3 parts:

- 1 at the start to cover costs and first 2 months of work 500 NEAR
- 2 at the completion of the first step as an agreement of completion 550 NEAR
- 3 at the completion of the last step as an agreement of completion 550 NEAR

We also agree to publish revision about how the project is going on weekly on the forum and to discuss them further on the Humanguild weekly meeting if needed.

Revision are needed to check the state of the project, in order to be able to update the project if things aren't going as expected (many things can change on a blockchain community in just one year), revision moments may be the right situations to change the schedule or to waive in an agreed way.

Intellectual property

I agree to publish the code under MIT license, the intellectual property for a character like Varda is public domain as she's from the Silmarillion book.
