

Summer Math Practice for Students Entering Grades 3



We want all of our students to relax and have fun over the break, and we also want them to head into the next school year feeling confident. Spending just a few minutes a day on math fact practice can make a huge difference in keeping those skills sharp. We have put together a guide detailing our digital summer math practice for MathFactLab.

Quick recall of math facts allows students to focus their brain power on learning new math concepts more easily. Practicing facts over the summer is a great way to keep learning fresh and help students start the next grade ready for success. Students will continue to have access to Math Fact Lab this summer.

As students prepare for 3rd grade, it is very important they are able to recall their **addition and subtraction facts**. Students should be starting 3rd grade at level L or higher.

Math Fact Lab recommends that students practice at least three times per week (if below level above) and complete one full session each time they log in. Each session only takes about 10–12 minutes.

Incoming 3rd graders will need to log in with the QR code and directions provided by 2nd grade teachers.

Directions to Log on to Math Fact Lab on a home device:

**The device must have a camera to scan the QR code, but cannot be a phone. (Math Fact Lab is not supported)

- 1) Type app.mathfactlab.com in the search bar.
- 2) Click sign in with QR code provided by your child's teacher.
- 3) Hold the QR code up to the camera. You should be able to start a session.
