RESOLUTION NO: 2024 - G6

RE: A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CARRYING OF A FIREARM ON COUNTY PROPERTY PURSUANT TO ITS AUTHORITY IN C.R.S. § 18-12-105.3 IN ALAMOSA COUNTY.

Commissioner _____ moved for the adoption of the following Resolution.
Commissioner _____ seconded the motion.

WHEREAS, in 2024, the Colorado Legislature passed Senate Bill 24-131 which was signed into law by the Governor on May 31, 2024 and relevant parts were codified as C.R.S. §18-12-105.3; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to C.R.S. §18-12-105.3(1)(b), “unless permitted by a local government, a person shall not knowingly carry a firearm, whether loaded or not loaded in any of the following locations, including their adjacent parking lots, including but not limited to the following:

1. The chambers or galleries of a local government's governing body are located,
2. A meeting of a local governments governing body is being conducted; or
3. The official office of any elected member of a local government's governing body or the Chief Executive officer of a local government is located; and

WHEREAS, Alamosa County is a local government and is authorized pursuant to C.R.S. §18-12—105.3(4)(b) to allow a person to carry a firearm, whether loaded or not loaded on the above-described locations.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board hereby authorizes a person to carry a firearm on the above-described premises subject to the following:

1. No person shall carry a firearm openly on the above-described premises
2. Any person carrying a firearm on the above-described premises must have a current concealed carry permit.
3. The firearm must remain on the person and out of view at all times.
