

## 7<sup>th</sup> Grade World Map Sequence

1. **Trace over** your world map 3-4 times in different colors
  - a. Fold it in half and half again to make four quadrants
2. **Free hand draw** the map on **8 ½ x 11** paper -- 3-4 times
3. **Free hand draw** the map on **11 x 17** paper -- 2 times
  - a. If you fold the paper first, you can draw by quadrant
  - b. Remember the seas in Asia (Black and Caspian)
4. **Carefully free hand draw** the map on **12 x 18** watercolor paper
  - a. Use a ruler to draw the prime meridian and the equator
  - b. Draw the continents
  - c. Use your study guide map to draw in (not label) the
    - i. Mountain ranges (8)
    - ii. Rivers (11)
    - iii. Black and Caspian Seas
5. Use crayon to **Wax Relief** all of the above lines. Choose your colors.
6. **Check** w/ your teacher to see if you're ready to paint
7. **Paint** carefully, slowly, and with lots of water.  
This is an art project. Choose your colors.
8. When your map is dry, use fine point and regular **sharpie to label**
  - 7 continents
  - 4 oceans
  - 8 mountain ranges
  - 11 rivers
  - 4 seas

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## 9. **Sign** your name! Congratulations!
