- **Best Face Forward:** Use 0.5–2% of Organic Tea Tree Oil in lotions, creams, or body butters to help maintain clear, balanced skin. Patch test to check for sensitivity and avoid sun exposure after use, as this oil may increase skin's sensitivity to UV rays.
- **Fresh Strands:** Add 1–2% of Tea Tree Organic Essential Oil (Australia) to shampoos, conditioners, or beard oils to promote scalp and hair health with a refreshing herbal boost.
- **Relax & Restore:** Add 5–10 drops (about 0.2–0.5%) of Tea Tree Organic Essential Oil (Australia) to bath water to soothe skin irritations and inflammation. Mix into massage oils at 1–3% for detoxifying relief.
- **Happy Feet & Nails:** Add 1–3% of Tea Tree Organic Essential Oil (Australia) to foot sprays or nail care products to keep toes and nails fresh and healthy.
- **Spruce Up Your Space:** Use 0.5–2% of Tea Tree Organic Essential Oil (Australia) in blends to bring natural cleansing power and a crisp, clean scent to your home environment.
