## AP Exam Registration Information and Deadlines

### Spring Semester 2024-2025

The 2025 AP Exams will be administered in school as **fully digital, hybrid, OR paper and pencil** exams during the first two weeks of May: May 5 – 9 and May 12 – 16 (**see schedule below**). AP students will log into their CollegeBoard accounts to access AP exam information and material for their AP courses. Please follow these directions to set up or retrieve your account with CollegeBoard and access AP exam information and course material for your AP courses:

#### **Action Items for Students:**

- Go to [myap.collegeboard.org](https://myap.collegeboard.org). If you already have established a CollegeBoard account, make certain that you can log in. If you have forgotten your password, you may call 888-225-5427 or click “Forgot Password.” ***It is very important for your name on your CollegeBoard account to match your name in PowerSchool.***
- AP teachers will provide students with a join code specific to their class and period.
- Follow prompts in your CollegeBoard account to join courses by **Friday, March 14, 2025**. **Students will automatically be registered to take the AP exam for each course they “join.”**
- If you do not desire to take the AP exam, please complete this [form \(AP Opt-Out Form\)](#) by **Friday, March 14, 2025**. **The CollegeBoard unused/cancelled exam fee for this school year is \$40.** Students who do not complete the Google form (above) by March 14<sup>th</sup> and do not take the AP exam for a 2<sup>nd</sup> semester class will be responsible for paying the \$40 fee.
- \*Joining a class will allow students access to a set of resources designed to provide them with practice opportunities and feedback throughout the year.

#### **Fees**

##### **What is the cost for AP exams?**

- **\$0** for students enrolled in the AP course during the 2024-2025 school year.
- **\$99** for Self-Study students (students not enrolled in the AP course during the 2024-2025 school year).

##### **What are the other fees associated with AP exams?**

- Students who do not “join” their 2<sup>nd</sup> semester or year-long AP course by the March 14<sup>th</sup> deadline will be required to pay a \$40 late fee, and in some cases, may not be able to order an AP exam for that course for the 2024-2025 school year.

As part of registering for a College Board Advanced Placement course offered by Cary High School, all teachers and administrators expect students to prepare for and take the AP exams for each corresponding course in May. Teachers dedicate considerable classroom instruction time to helping ensure that students are prepared for their AP exams. In addition, research shows that students who take their AP exams, regardless of their final score on College Board tests, perform at higher levels in college and graduate at a much higher four-year rate compared to peers who opt out of their AP exams.

*Though it is not suggested, families may request to opt their student out of taking an AP College Board exam. Having heard and understood the information articulated regarding our child's College Board Advanced Placement testing expectation, we choose to exercise the option **NOT** to have our child take the AP exam. We understand that if our child changes her/his mind at a later date, the option to take the exam may no longer be available and there will be a late fee of \$40.*
