4. Treasurer Report. Duane reports that \$713.92 spent since Labor Day; lots of expenses coming due for the summer: landscaping, garbage, insurance, etc.

 - C. Park-Update on:
 - 1. Plaques on the new memorial bench cost \$8, Carrie will share with us the name of woman who made them to keep them uniform; Association will pay for plaques—Jamie will work to generate a list of members to be remembered and send.

Posts along the fence by the street were straightened out from being hit over the winter

Garbage pick up will not pick up tires, as a reminder.

A tree was removed a year and a half ago—should we put another one in? Will have a proposal at the Labor Day Meeting—Andy Bennett will seek a proposal.
