This report details the activity that occurred during the Community Service – Donation Drive on December 2, 2025, Tuesday. The chosen Supreme Student Government officers and the Thinker (Journalists) students together with Sir Dave Dehito, Sir Nevie Ermac, Mrs. Gretchin San Juan and Ma'am Jade Barros who helped in facilitating during the activity. The fire-affected communities were located at San Nicolas, Buhangin, Davao City and Bayview, Sasa Km. 11.

The Supreme Student Government Organization conducted a room-to-room collecting of donations. Each grade level were assigned to bring their respective donations and were given 3 days to bring those. Right after the 3 days, SSG officers started to pack and prepare the bags. Each bags contains of 2kls of rice, shampoo, soap, toothpaste, canned goods, noodles, coffee, milk and biscuits. With the cooperation of each other, the packaging were finished within 1 day. Additionally, to formally cooperate with the communities, the SSG officers had the chance to talk to the Kagawad of the Buhangin and the Sasa. They gathered all the data – 38 in Buhangin and 22 in Sasa. The bags were surely and safely arranged in the T.L.E room.

On December 2, 2025, Tuesday, at 9:30 A.M., the SSG officers were excused to their respective classes to attend the operation. They prepared the bags and put it at the guard house while waiting the pick-up car. Before leaving the school, they had their quick meeting on what will be the process and things to consider. After that, when the pick-up arrived, they headed first to Buhangin. The victims currently staying at Waling-Waling Covered Court. They started to distribute the donations to the individuals with love, joy, and gladness in their hearts. Next, the evacuation site of Sasa victims was located at Sasa Km. 11 Bayview Basketball Court. While distributing, the officers showed their greatest gratitude and relief because they had already finished their project. After the Sasa, the students sent back to the school to rest and stay.

In conclusion, helping wholeheartedly is really a great gesture that we can show to ourselves and even to someone. The Supreme Student Government truly enjoyed and cherished the special moment during their project. It was a great plan and decision that the Davao Wisdom Academy was able to help the individuals that experienced an awful fire case.
