Accessing Wifi and Classroom Resources on a Personal Mobile Device



Your child's school is now using ClassLink, a single sign-on platform that will allow teachers and students to use one username and password to access everything they need. ClassLink will serve as your child's homebase for digital education resources.

Here is how to help get your child started on ClassLink and the programs they use on a personal <u>mobile device</u>:

 Download all the appropriate app/apps from: <u>IOS</u> <u>Google Play</u>

***Your child's class uses these apps: ClassLink, Kids A-Z Learning, Bookcreator and Brainpop.












2. Click on ClassLink and search for "Waterford Public SD" to find the school specific sign in. For example:

Quaker Hill Elementary School Waterford Public SD, Connecticut	4 mi	

3. Enter the student username and password. (Your child should know this from school) or use the QuickCard the teacher provides.

Your child has already logged into each of these apps in school. ClassLink holds onto usernames and passwords and we also auto-roster, so your child should be able to get into their assignments and work as soon as they click on the correct app.
