YEARS of dedication... gone.

I remember thinking to myself, "While the rest of us are stuck, slaving away at our job... who the f*ck has the freedom to consistently go to a random coffee shop at 11:30 am sharp?".

To give you some context...

A friend of mine used to work at a coffee shop.

9-5... 37 hours a week, £7.50 an hour (ouch).

And, his desire to leverage his time in a 'wiser and smarter way' came very apparent to him when this tall, muscular, cleanly shaven, Louis Vuitton-wearing, clearly rich man came into the coffee shop at 11:30 am **every** Wednesday.

And, after he told me... it pissed me off; I couldn't handle it.

Listen... let me paint a simple picture for you...

While you are working 8 hours a day, 5 days a week, not only working on your boss's dreams but also being at a particular place when he says so, doing what he wants whenever he wants it, embodying the definition of a slave (look it up)...

There are people in the world driving whatever car they want, traveling wherever they want, gathering the *sexy* girls they want.

It's rather depressing, isn't it?

And listen, the definition of a slave is for someone to 'force you' to work for them. And... that isn't the case in your situation, right?
