Swim at Your Own Risk Pool Rules and Regulations

The Churchill Estates Homes Association (CEHA) offers swim at your own risk (SAYOR) to residents who are current on CEHA dues, have met with a CEHA Board member, to have this Board member witness you signing the CEHA SAYOR Release and Waiver of Liability and this SAYOR Pool Rules and Regulations form and to follow these rules and regulations as set forth:

1. In order to participate in SAYOR, residents must provide proof of residency in Churchill Estates, such as a driver's license or CPS bill, and must be current with their CEHA dues.
2. SAYOR is available year round, Tuesday through Saturday between 6 AM and 9 PM, and on Monday between 5 PM and 9 PM.
3. No glass of any kind allowed in the pool area.
4. No illegal drugs allowed in the Recreational Park or Pool area. Swimming under the influence of alcohol or drugs is strictly prohibited.
5. No SAYOR during Churchill Estates Stallion Swim Team practice, meets, or functions.
6. No SAYOR during maintenance of the Churchill Estates pool.
7. No diving off moveable and/or stationary objects including but not limited pool equipment or lifeguard stands. No climbing or sitting on lifeguard stands.
8. No bicycles or skateboards on the pool deck.
9. Resident(s) must be present and stay with any underage family member and all guest(s) during the duration of the pool visit. Residents are responsible for the actions and well-being of members of their household and all guest(s) in the pool area during SAYOR.
10. Children aged 17 or younger must be supervised by an adult during SAYOR.
11. Each resident is limited to five guests in the pool area at a time during SAYOR.
12. Horseplay is strictly prohibited, including but not limited to running, wrestling, dunking, and pushing others into the water.
13. Residents are required to close the gate everytime they are going in or out of the pool area. Propping the gate open and tailgating to enter are prohibited.
14. Residents are responsible to keep restrooms clean after each use.
15. Residents are responsible for disposal of all garbage in the pool area during SAYOR.

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16. No Offensive Behavior. Any act that invades the privacy rights of others, such as touching or threatening to touch another person in a sexual, rude, insolent, or angry manner is not tolerated. No offensive language, threats or acts of violence tolerated.
17. No sexual activity of any kind allowed.
18. The pool must be cleared immediately at the first sound of thunder or sight of lightning.
19. CEHA limits SAYOR key fobs to one free keyfob per household with an option of purchasing one additional key fob.
20. Residents are prohibited from transferring and/or loaning their SAYOR keyfob to unauthorized persons.
21. Residents must display their SAYOR key fob upon request by CEHA officers, directors, or employees when participating in SAYOR.
22. Residents will be charged a fee for lost, stolen or damaged SAYOR key fobs.
23. Pets are not permitted in the pool area with the exception of service animals with proper identification.
24. Board of Directors, lifeguard(s) and/or officers of the Association will have absolute authority to determine the interpretation of the pool rules and policies.
