



Erasmus Mundus Scholarship APPLICATION FORM for entry to GLOCAL in September 2023

To be considered for the Erasmus Mundus Scholarship, please read the following carefully.

You can access an editable version of this form by going to File and then Download – **please ensure you download this in .docx format**. Complete this form carefully, and then sign and date it, **save the form as a PDF file**, and upload it to your GLOCAL application **along with all other supporting documentation required**:

- This form, with your preferred study track clearly marked
- CV (Any format is acceptable, Europass is preferred)
- Two supporting reference letters on headed paper.
 - References must be dated within 24 months from the date of submission of the application
 - They must be on institutional headed paper or with an official stamp. If neither are available a reference can be submitted directly to erasmusreferences@glasgow.ac.uk from the referee's institutional email address. References will not be accepted from a personal email address.
 - References must be signed with an electronic or wet-ink signature. A typed name is not sufficient
 - At least one of the two references should be an academic reference. One may be a professional reference where it is not possible to obtain two academic references.
- Transcripts of all university-level academic studies to date (undergraduate and any postgraduate studies) Studies earlier than university are not required.

IMPORTANT:

Scholarship applications that do not have all of the above by the scholarship deadline will be treated as incomplete **and will not be considered**.

If you're still studying, final degree certificates and English language certificates are not required by the Consortium when considering Scholarship applications, but they are required documents for an Unconditional offer from the University of Glasgow. They may be submitted later, after you've submitted your scholarship application documents.

2. To be eligible for an Erasmus Mundus Scholarship, an applicant:

- **must not** have previously received an Erasmus Mundus Master Course (Action 1) Scholarship
- **must** complete this Scholarship Application Form and return it, as instructed, no later than **6 January 2023** to be considered for an Erasmus Mundus Scholarship commencing September 2023
- **must** have submitted ALL of the required supporting documents by 6 January 2023. If your offer status is 'holding for documents' then you will **NOT be considered** for a scholarship unless you submit the required documents by 6 January 2023. The only exception to this is final degree certificates where the applicant has not yet completed their Bachelor degree at the time of application, and English language proficiency certificates.
- **must** have addressed all the requirements described on the GLOCAL website.

You qualify as a Programme country applicant (and must apply as a Programme country applicant) if you fulfil either of these 2 conditions:

- You are a national of a Programme country

OR

- You are a national of a Partner country who has been resident or has carried out your main activity (studies, training or work) for more than a total of 12 months over the last five years in any Programme country/countries. The five-year period is calculated backwards from the submission deadline, i.e. 6 January 2023.

All other applicants should apply as a **Partner Country applicant**.

3. Personal Statement

IMPORTANT: Samples of academic work will not be taken into consideration and should not be submitted.

Please be as precise as you can when writing your Supporting Personal Statement. Do not repeat yourself and **do not exceed the word limit (1,200 words)**. You should make sure that you address the following issues in your personal statement:

- You should outline your motivation for choosing the GLOCAL programme (i.e. how it complements and develops your previous studies; how it relates to your potential future career path; how it relates to your personal and academic interests).
- Explain why you think you are a good candidate for the programme given your previous studies and how they relate to the courses offered on the programme in both years.
- If you have significant post-graduation work experience, please explain how those activities relate to the courses offered in the programme and why you are re-entering the academic world.
- Briefly indicate what you might see as being the topic of your Masters thesis (this can change later).
- You should highlight your participation in conferences, internships, non-governmental organisations, summer schools, and other socially sensitive or political activity; as well as any prizes/awards received even if these activities are not specially connected to the area of Global Markets & Local Creativities.
