

These guidelines are subject to change. Anyone who needs to withdraw from attending camp prior to Sunday morning arrival for any health related reason will be reimbursed fully for their cost of camp.

People of God Summer Camp 2024 Health & Wellness Plan

Pre-Camp Guidelines:

We kindly ask that you please stay home if you are experiencing any of the following symptoms: fever or chills, severe cough, sore throat, shortness of breath, fatigue or body aches, vomiting, or diarrhea.

Within 48 hours prior to camp arrival (12:00pm on Friday, July 12), if anyone in your household has a fever, your child needs to be fever free (unmedicated) for 24 hours. We understand this could delay your child's camp arrival to Monday or Tuesday.

If you are unable to attend camp due to any of the above, we will issue a full refund for the cost of camp. Unfortunately, we are not able to refund the cost of airfare or other travel expenses.

Please review with your child proper hand washing technique and how to sneeze/cough into their elbow.

Camp Arrival:

Registration will be in the pavilion this year. Families will be able to park their vehicle in the field and walk their camper(s) through the registration tables in the pavilion. Luggage will be sorted by the service team to transport up the cabins for the campers.

Please remove all medications from any luggage prior to walking to the pavilion. All camper medications must be checked in with the camp nurses at the time of registration.

Junior counselors & staff are available to escort campers to their cabin upon completion of their check-in.

Illness / Dismissal from Camp

It is possible that someone (camper or staff) will become ill during the week. If this were to occur, the following protocol will be followed:

If a child becomes ill with fever, nausea, vomiting, diarrhea we will separate them from camp activities. They will be moved into the nurses cabin & attended to by the camp nurses. The nurses will monitor the situation & determine if the need for dismissal from camp is required. A designated family member will be contacted to come and pick up any camper and/or junior staff member as needed.

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Return to Camp after Dismissal:

Individuals who are dismissed from camp due to health and wellness protocols and wish to return must be symptom & fever free for at least 24 hours without medication. The potential for a return to camp is upon the discretion of the nursing staff and director team & will be evaluated on a case-by-case basis as needed.
