Purpose - Why do we process your personal data?

The University of Deusto processes the data provided to:

- 1. Manage the application and admission process to the University to pursue undergraduate, postgraduate, doctoral and executive education programmes offered by the University of Deusto.
- 2. Manage the application and admission process to pursue continuing education programmes.
- 3. Manage the delivery of information about activities and services offered by the University of Deusto by physical and electronic means.
- 4. Make preference profiling and follow-up on activities held.

Legitimisation - What is the lawful basis for processing your personal data?

The lawful basis for the processing of your personal data is the applicant's consent for the processing of their personal data by submitting or signing the previously informed consent form.

If you do not provide the requested information, your application will not be processed.

In the case of information about the activities and services offered by the UD and the elaboration of preference and activity profiles, the lawful basis for the processing is the consent and/or legitimate interests of the UD.

Recipients - Who will be the recipients of your personal data?

The processing of your application does not involve the transfer of your personal information to third parties, unless otherwise provided by law.

Nor does it involve the international transfer of said information.

International transfers

They do not occur in the scope of this processing.

Data storage period - How long is my information kept?

The personal data collected will be stored until enrolment or registration is made, or for a maximum period of 6 years.

Likewise, the data required for the submission of commercial communications and profiling will be stored for the same period of time.

Your data will be stored for statistical purposes and your personal details will be removed.

Rights - What are your rights when you provide your personal data to us?

Any person will have the right to obtain from the University of Deusto confirmation as to whether or not personal data concerning him or her are being processed.

Those concerned have the right to request access to their personal data and rectification of inaccurate data or, where that is the case, request erasure of personal data when, among other reasons, the data are no longer necessary for the purposes they were collected.

In some circumstances, those concerned may request restriction of processing of personal data, in which case these will only be stored for the exercise or defence of legal claims.

In certain circumstances or for reasons related to a specific situation, those concerned may object to the processing of their personal data. The University of Deusto will no longer process, unless the centre responsible demonstrates compelling legitimate grounds for the processing, or for the exercise or defence of legal claims.

Those concerned may request data portability to receive personal data concerning him or her which have been provided to the University of Deusto in a structured, commonly used, machine-readable and interoperable format, to be downloaded or transmitted directly from the University of Deusto to another entity.
