## **Parent Exam Prep Guide**

## How can you help your student prepare for exams?

- Take time to go over their schedule/calendar with them.
  - Plan tutorial times.
  - Know when their exam review parts are due.
  - Go through Skyward to be sure they don't have missing assessments or assignments.

## Have your student teach you!

- o Take their review and quiz them -- active review is best.
- Look at the main concepts from their reviews and ask them to teach you as if you don't know anything about it.
- Remember to ask them big picture questions in addition to the details.
- Play a review game with them...and try to beat them.
  - Lots of teachers have links to Kahoots, Gimkits, Quizizzes, and Blookets available as study material. Set a timer and try to win against your student!

## Print an extra copy or two of their reviews.

- Have them try the first review without any notes and highlight the questions they didn't know without hesitating.
- Then, have them get out notes and fill in the rest (over the highlights!). This helps them to see what they're needing to study the most.
- A few days later, have them try a new copy of the review. Is the amount highlighted decreasing? It should be!

\*All students will have access to an exam review key <u>upon</u>

<u>completion of their review</u>, so they'll have their own key once they

correct it in class or tutorials!
