Adelphi Friends Meeting—

- A. Has decided to improve its present facilities rather than move elsewhere;
- B. Approves the "Final Design Criteria" on page 41 of the Charrette report presented to Adelphi business meeting in December 2012, which lists:

Accessible spaces for worship and social gatherings with a way to easily move from one to the other.

Accessible restrooms

A larger social space and more functional kitchen

A worship space with an adjacent space that can be used for special events but not necessarily every Sunday

Six classrooms of varying sizes with access t the playground for the younger children and a place apart (but not too far apart) for the Young Friends

Better site circulation and use of outdoor space

C. Adopts the following, additional **Project Guidelines**:

Project Guideline 1: Construction is to be planned to minimize disruption of our community worship and social life;

Project Guideline 2: Public areas at Adelphi Meeting are to be wheelchair accessible;

Project Guideline 3: "Green" practices shall guide property improvements, balancing the cost of capital investment and projected energy usage.
